*** REPORT OF SURVEYOR **

TO THE HON. COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, ORE:

I, the undersigned, County Surveyor, appointed to survey the County Road proposed by R. S. Shaw, et al., beg leave to report that on the 21st day of June, 1916, in pursuance of said appointment and order, I surveyed said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, the following being the field notes of said survey:-


Beginning at a stake marked "R", 30 feet South of the corner to Sections 26-27-34-35, T.5 S., R.39 E.W.M., running thence South along the line between sections 34 and 35 4270 feet, to angle 1, thence 90 deg. left, 1415 feet to angle 2, thence 50 deg. 30 min. right, 1335 feet to angle 3, thence 50 deg. 30 min. left, along South line Section 35, 386 feet to angle 4, the South $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 35, thence 89 deg. 09 min. right, along N. & S. E line Sec. 2, T. 6 S., R. 39 E.W.M., 3694 feet to angle 5, thence 89 deg. 09 min. left, 1300 feet to angle 6, thence 65 deg. 30 min right, 1100 feet to angle 7, thence 36 deg left, 1048 feet to a rock marked "R T" in the County Road near the S.E.Cor. sec. 2, T. 6 S., R. 39 E.W.M.

And that the field notes made by me are true and correct, and that the accompanying plat is true and correct representation of said road, both in an^gle and distance.

To angle 5 the proposed route as shown on the plat is as practicable as can be obtained, but from angle 5 on, a much better location can be found than either the one shown on the plat or contained in the petition.

The total length of the proposed road is,14,548 feet.

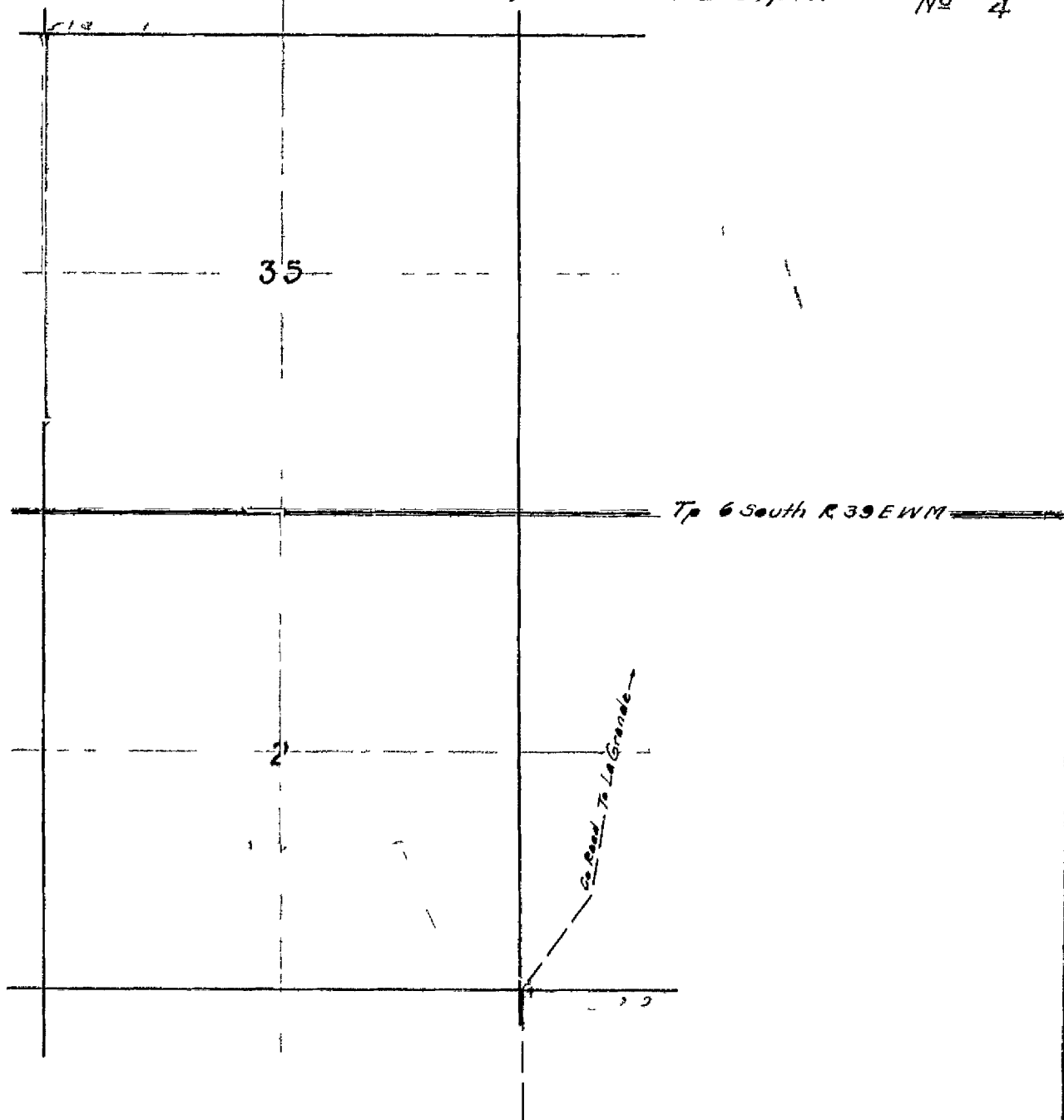
