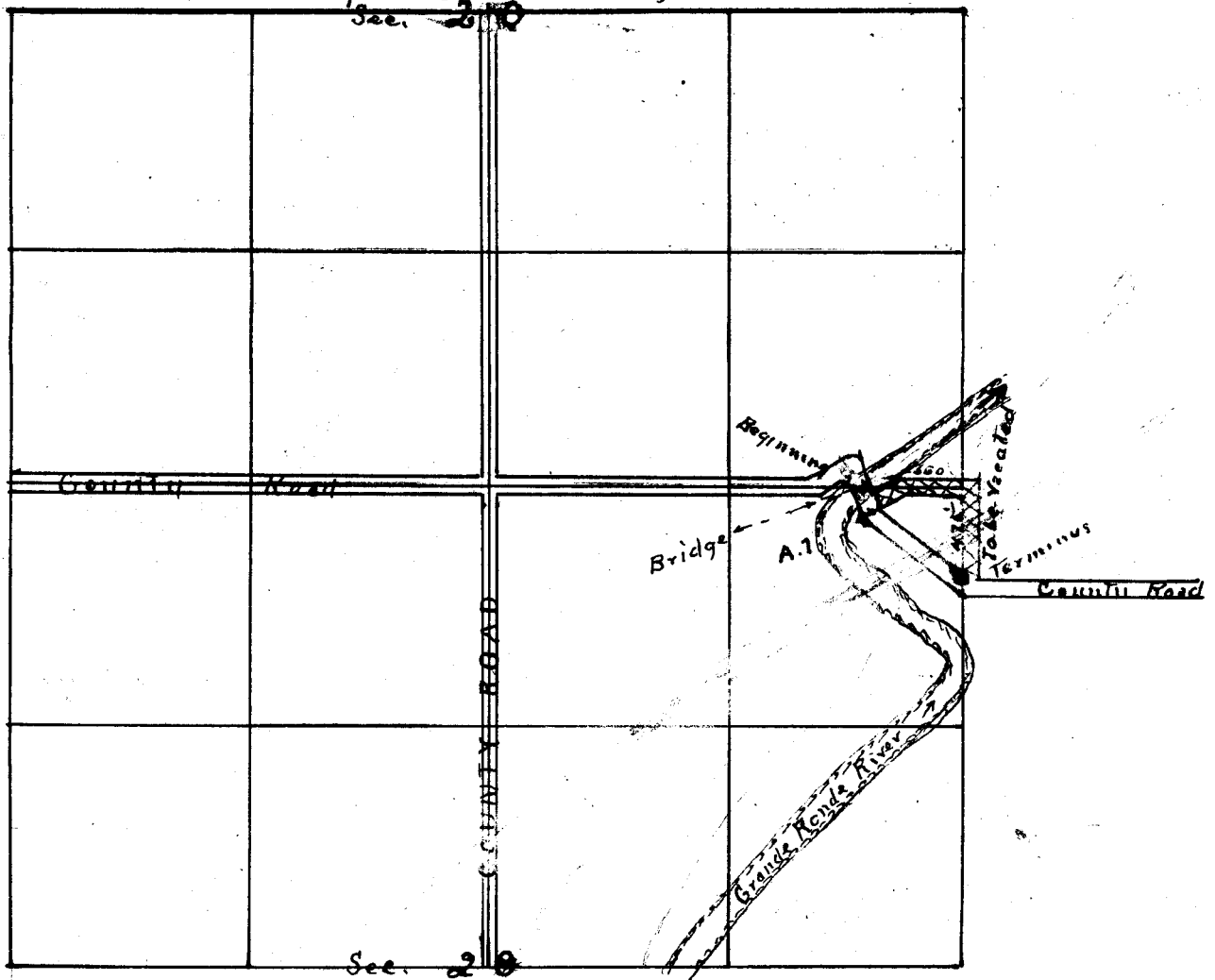

In the matter of the proposed County Road petitioned for by Hans Westenskow et al.

Comes now Hans Westenskow, one of the petitioners for the above named proposed County Road, and presents to the court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a county road, described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the east end of the county bridge east of Imbler, on the section line between sections 20 and 29, Tp. 1 S.R. 39 E.W.M., running thence south and east a distance of about 40 rods on the most practicable route to intersect the County road running east and west in front of the H. McGoldrick buildings, which buildings are located on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 28, Tp. 1 S.R. 39 E.W.M. in Union County, Oregon.

Now at this time it is ORDERED that this matter be, and the same is hereby continued for the term.

In the matter of the proposed county road petitioned for by Cecil Thompson et al.

Now at this time it is ORDERED by the Court that this matter be and the same is hereby denied.

In the matter of the proposed vacation of county road petitioned for by T.M.Rankin et al.

Now at this time this matter came on to be heard upon the petition of T.M.Rankin et al for the vacation of that certain county road within Union County, beginning at a point on the present county road where it crosses the quarter section line running east and west through the center of Sec. 20, Tp. 3 S.R. 37 E.W.M., thence running along said road southeasterly to the southeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 29, said township and range, thence south along said road to the southeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, in said township and range, and there terminate.

And it appearing to the court that said road should be vacated it is CONSIDERED and ORDERED that said road be, and the same is hereby vacated as petitioned for.

In the matter of the proposed county road petitioned for by Hans Westenskow et al.

This matter came to be heard at this time on the report of the Board of County Road Viewers for a second reading, as provided by law, said report being in words following to-wit:

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers heretofore on the 4th day of April, 1917, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached in a true and correct description, as petitioned for by Hans Westenskow et al., beg leave to report that on the 17 day of April, 1917, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add greatly to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county and that the present road laying between the beginning and terminus be vacated.

And said report of the Board of County Road Viewers having been now publicly read in open court on two several days of the present term of the court, and it appearing to the

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court that said Board of County Road Viewers report favorably thereon, and recommend that said proposed road be established as a county road and be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the proceedings herein having been regular and according to law, and no remonstance or claim for damages having been filed herein, and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public highway and ordered open according to law, and that portion of the present road lying between the beginning and the terminus of the new road petitioned for be vacated, and the court being satisfied from the report of the Board of County Road Viewers that such road will be of public utility; the report of the viewers being favorable thereto, and all the files and records of said proceedings having been submitted to the District Attorney, who has advised this court as to the legality of said proceedings, it is therefore CONSIDERED and ORDERED by the Court that the report of the Board of County road viewers be placed on record in this journal, and that the surveyor's profile and plat of the proposed road, and his field-notes of the survey thereof be placed on record in the Book of Plats of County Roads of Union County, Oregon, and that said proposed road be declared a public highway of Union County, Oregon, and ordered opened up and placed in repair for travel according to law, and that portion of the present road lying between the beginning and the terminus of the new road petitioned for be vacated, and that Willis Wright, Road Supervisor of Road District No. 6, the same being the road district in which said road is located, be furnished with a copy of the petition herein, and a copy of this decree and ordered to open up said road and place the same in repair for travel.

Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned until tomorrow, July 7th, 1917, at 9 o'clock A.M.
