REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS.

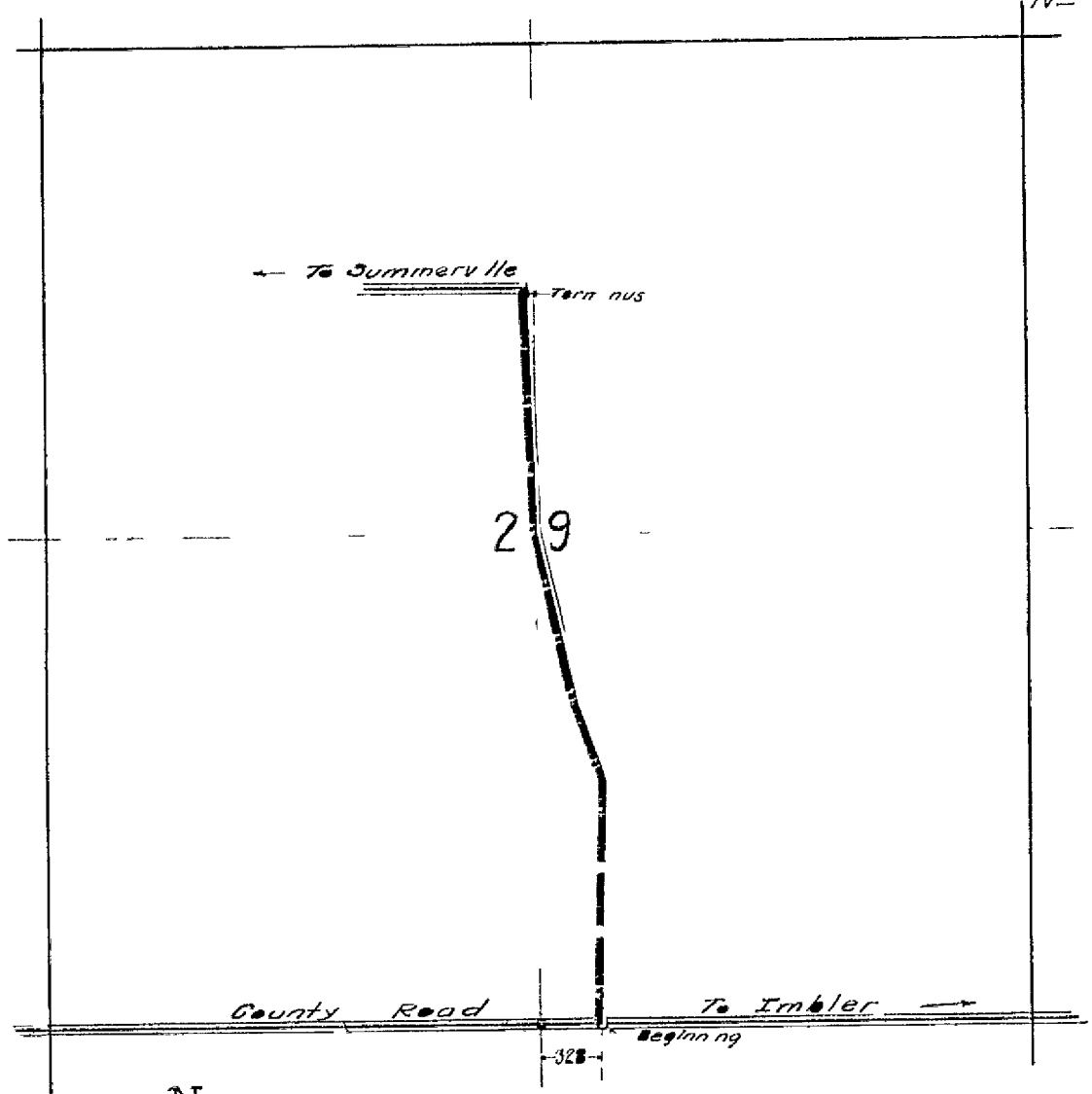
To the *Honorable County Court for Union County, Oregon:*
