Comes now C. W. Bond one of the petitioners for the above named proposed County Road and presents to the Court the petition of himself and others, praying for the location and establishment of a County Road, described as follows, towit: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 10, being the corner common to Sections 9, 10, 15, and 16, in Tp. 3, S. R. 39 E.W.M., thence South to the SW corner of said Section 15, thence West along the Section line to the Southwest corner of Section 13, in Tp. 3, S. R. 38 E.W.M.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by more than twelve free-holders of this County, residing in the road district where the hereinbefore described road is proposed to be, and that said petition properly specifies the place of beginning, intermediate points and place of termination of said road, and it satisfactorily appearing to the court that notice has been given by advertisement posted at the place of holding County Court, towit:— At the Court House in the City of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, and also in three public places in the vicinity of said proposed road, towit:— One on a telephone pole near the beginning of said proposed road, one on a bridge on the property of the E. O.
