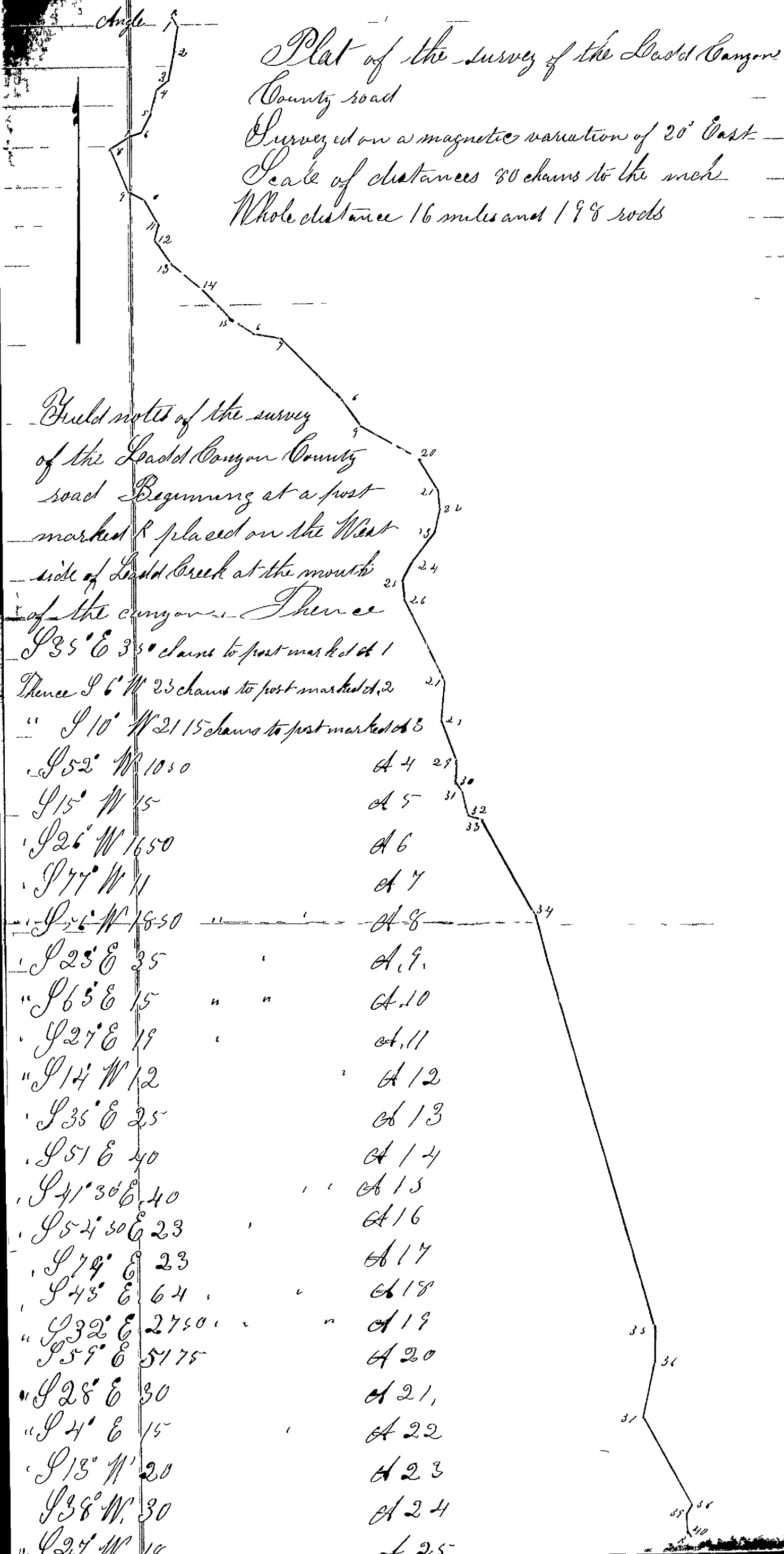

Second Judicial Day

Court met pursuant to adjournment
Same Officers present as on yesterday.

Due proclamation of the opening of
Court having been made - the following
proceedings were had.

In the matter of petitions
for the purchase of
County Road

Whereas there is a
petition presented to the County Court of
Union County State of Oregon, praying
for said Court to appropriate money for
the purchase of a certain Road in said
County. Known as the Ladd Canyon road
It having come to the knowledge of said
Court that A Morrison holds a Mortgage
on said Road. Therefore be it Ordered by the
County Court of Union Co. Oreg that the Clerk
of said County be and he is hereby instructed
to notify said Morrison to appear before said
Court on the second day of March Term
1875 for the purpose of investigating matters
relative to said road and petition.

No further business appearing the Court
adjourned until tomorrow morning at 9
O'clock A.M.

The Court find that Petition has 69 legal votes thereon, and that the remonstrance has 71 legal votes thereon and that the petitioner R. J. Williams has not presented a petition of a majority of the legal voters of said precinct, and Order that his application be rejected.

Therefore the petitioner by W. P. Bull atty. objecting to the counting on the remonstrance the names of J. J. Cuthouse and E. A. Collins on the ground of nonresidence, not before objected to, which said objection was overruled by the court.

In the Matter of Purchasing
County Road, Ladd Canyon

Now at this time was presented a petition of the Citizens of Union County, praying the County Court to purchase the Ladd Canyon Toll Road. And at the same time was also presented a remonstrance from other citizens, praying that the same be not granted, and it appearing to the court that a majority of one hundred and one legal voters were on said petition over and above said remonstrance, It is therefore, Ordered and decreed that the Judge of this Court be empowered to enter into negotiations for the purpose of purchasing said road, subject to the approval of a majority of the Court,

At a Regular Term Term of the County
 County Court of the State of Oregon for
 the County of Union, begun and held
 at the Court house in Union, in said
 County, on Wednesday the 8th day of Nov
 1876. There was present Hon E. B. Baird
 County Judge, F. J. Dick & Jesse Imbler Co
 Commissioners, S. O. Swackhamer Sheriff
 & R. S. Bates Clerk.

Due proclamation of the opening of Court
 having been duly made the following
 proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of Ladd vs
 West Canyon Toll Road.

Whereas, by an order
 of this Court, heretofore duly made, the Judge
 of this Court was authorized to contract
 for & purchase what is known as Ladd
 Canyon Toll Road, and Whereas the Judge
 aforesaid by authority in him ~~is~~ vested
 did bargain for and purchase said ~~road~~
 road, which is hereby accepted by the full
 board of Co Commissioners now in session,
 and in order to establish & mark said
 road, Willis Skiff County Surveyor is hereby
 appointed to survey, mark & make official
 plat of same, in accordance with
 the description of said road now on
 file ^{as} appears in the articles of Incorporation
 of the "West Canyon Road Company,"
 said description being as follows.

Commencing at a post in Grand
 Bend Valley on West side of Road, ^{near the house}
 of E. Bouton, and taking at the route of
 said Road, up the Valley, Canyon, or Gulch
 of West Canyon, creek or branch & either
 or both sides of said creek, Canyon, or
 Gulch, and on such other ground as
 may be found best and necessary,
 to, and terminating at a post near
 north Powder River Bridge in Powder

River Valley. (which said creek is sometimes called Ladds Creek, and report the same to the January Term 1877. of this Court)

In the matter of Receiving }
bids for keeping Paupers. }^{ss}

Now on this day it was ordered that the clerk of this Co prepare & have published a notice that bids will be received by the Co Court up to the first day of Commissioners Court (of Jan Term 1877) of Union Co, for keeping, boarding, Lodging & furnishing medical attendance for the County Paupers of said Co for a term of one year from the 7th day of Jan 1877. said bids to be sealed.

In the matter of appointment }
of Justice of the Peace for }
Wallowa Precinct }

Now on this day it appearing to the Court that the Office Justice of the Peace in Wallowa Precinct is vacant, and that J. M. McKinney would be a suitable person for said Office. It is therefore ordered that J. M. McKinney be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace for Wallowa Precinct,

In the matter of appointment }
of Justice of the Peace for }
Silver Lake Precinct }

Now on this day it appearing to the Court that the Office of Justice of the Peace in Silver Lake Precinct in this Co. Co is vacant.

It is therefore ordered that John McCall be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace for Silver Lake Precinct in this Co.

Whereupon the Court adjourned until tomorrow morning at 9 O'clock

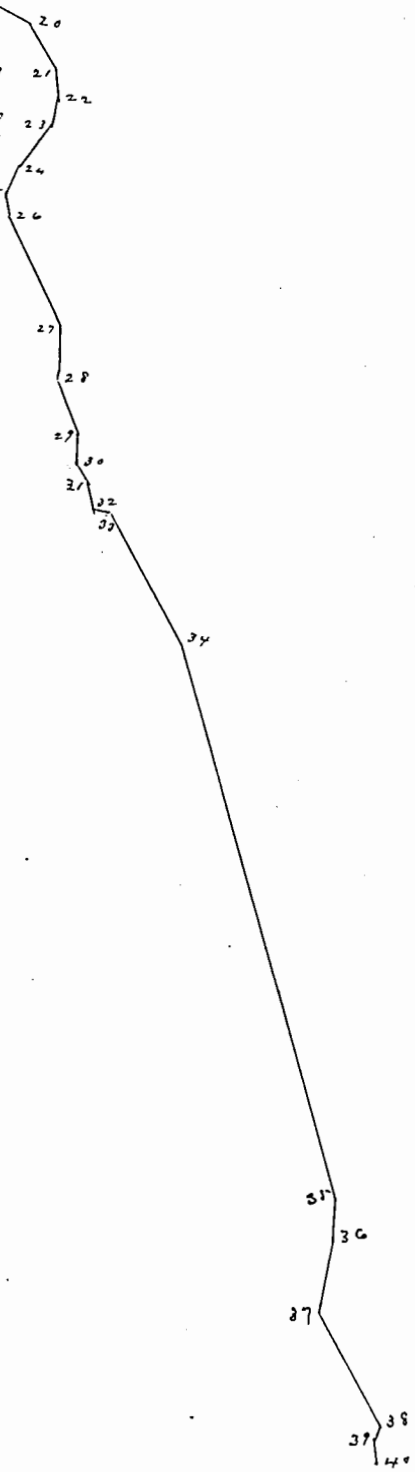


Plat of the Survey of the Ladd Canyon County Road.
