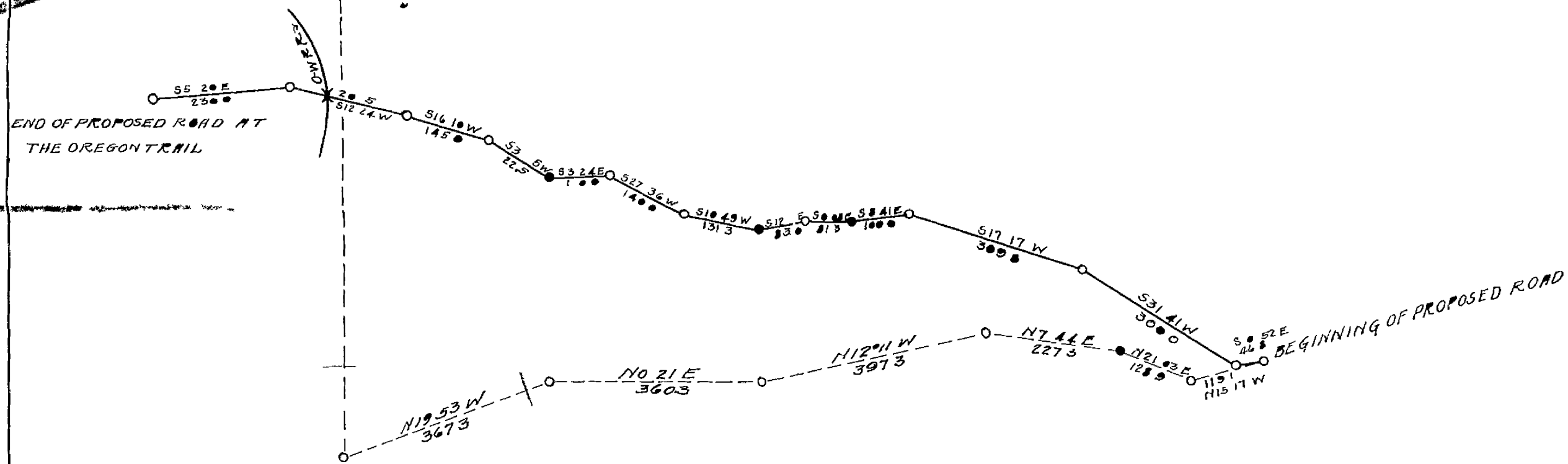

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

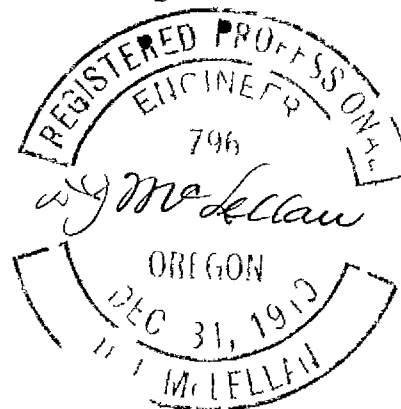
The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore on the 5th day of JANUARY 1921, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by G.E. Stoddard et al., beg leave to report that on the 13th & 21st days of January, 1921, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said county and that no damages be allowed for right of way for the proposed road.

The undersigned Board of County Road viewers, heretofore on the 5th day of January 1921, instructed to view, lay out and alter the proposed county road, of which the survey hereto attached is a true and correct description, as petitioned for by G. E. Stoddard, et al., beg leave to report that on the 12th & 21st days of January, 1921, in pursuance with said order, we proceeded to view out said proposed road for the whole distance thereof, and that in our opinions said proposed road should be laid out and established as a public highway of Union County, Oregon; that the same is practicable and would add to the convenience of the householders residing in the vicinity thereof. We therefore recommend that said proposed road be laid out and declared a public highway of said County and that no damages be allowed for right of way for the proposed road.

And it appearing to the Court that said Board of County Road Viewers report as favorable and that they recommend that said proposed road be established as a County Road and declaring it a Public Highway of Union County, Oregon, and all the proceedings herein have been legal and according to law and no remonstrance or claim for

damages have been filed, and there having been no cause shown why this proposed road should not be declared a public Highway and ordered open according to law and the Court being satisfied from the report of said Board of County Road Viewers that said road will be of public utility,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said report be accepted and placed on record in the Journal of this Court, and that the Surveyor's profile and plat of the proposed road and his field notes of survey thereof be placed on record in the book of plats of County Roads of Union County, Oregon; and that said proposed road be and the same is hereby declared a Public Highway of Union County, Oregon, conditioned upon the petitioners paying all the expenses necessary in the opening of said road except the grading which Union County hereby agrees to do. And

It further appearing to the Court that said proposed road follows the general alignment of an existing county road, and that the opening of said proposed road will render a portion of the existing road useless, it is further ORDERED that that portion of said existing road lying between what is known as the Country Club House and the beginning of said proposed road be vacated.
