# Petition for County Road

To the Honorable County Court, for Union County, Oregon:

The undersigned freeholders, of Union County, Oregon, residing in the Road District where the hereinafter described road is proposed to be, respectfully petition your honorable body to lay out, alter and establish a County Road within said county, on the following line or route, to-wit:

..... Commencing.. at a point One hundred ten rods West of the North-east corner of Section 34. Township 2. North. Range 40. East of the Willamette Meridian and about 30 rods West of what is known as the "Sam. Thompson House", thence running South along the West side of the Canyon a distance about one and one-eighth mile to the residence of George Yarrington, thence running South-east following the Canyon along the most practicable route a distance about three-fourths of a mile to the Highway, terminating on said Highway at a point about five rods <sup>below</sup> the "Matt. Boswell barn". The road to be 60 feet wide. A public necessity for this road exists in that it will afford a better grade than that now in use and will also afford ~~three~~ miles more of Highway for public travel. And in duty bound, your petitioners will ever pray, &c.

"Commencing at a point 110 Rds west of the NE corner of Sec 34 Twp 2 N R 40 E W M about 30 rds west of what is known as the Sam Thompson house thence running south along the east side of the canyon a distance about one and 1/8 mile to the residence of Geo Yarrington, thence southeast following the canyon along the most practicable route a distance of about 3/4 mile to the highway terminating on said highway at a point about 5 rods below the Matt Boswell barn the road to be 50 ft wide, a public necessity for this road exists in that it will afford a better grade than now in use and will also afford five miles more of highway for public travel."

do hereby remonstrate against said petition and against the construction of said road in that it is unnecessary, unuseful and would be used by very few people and is a duplication of a road which at present parallels the proposed road about 1/4 mile to the east which serves the same people and with but little expense the present road could be repaired into first class condition to handle the loads of traffic originating from the section served, and we believe the proposed road wholly unnecessary and an extra tax burden upon the residents of Union County and that we are taxpayers and residents of the immediate vicinity of said petitioned road.
