PETITION FOR VACATION OF STREET

To the Honorable County Court of Union County, State of Oregon:

We, the undersigned, being all the property owners abutting and adjoining that part of Hall Street extending from the Northeasterly side of Jefferson Avenue to the Southwest boundary line of the O-W.R. & N. Company's right of way, which part of Hall Street lies between Lot 11, Block 3, and Lot 1, Block 4 of Carr's Subdivision of Blocks 13 and 14 of Honan's Addition to the City of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, respectfully show:

That petitioner Fletcher Oil Company is a corporation, duly organized under the laws of the State of Oregon, with its principal office and place of business at La Grande, Oregon; that petitioner Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company is a corporation, duly organized under the laws of the State of Oregon, with its principal office and place of business at Portland, Oregon;

That petitioners are the several owners in fee simple and in the exclusive possession of all the property abutting and adjoining Hall Street, as above described, to-wit: that petitioner Fletcher Oil Company, a corporation, is the owner of Lot 11, Block 3, said Carr's Subdivision, and petitioner Maude M. Johnson is the owner of Lot 1, Block 4, said Carr's Sub-

division, and that petitioner Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, a corporation, is the owner of a right of way along the Northeasterly end of that part of Hall Street lying between the lots and blocks last above described;

That the above named petitioners, as owners of the property above described, are the owners of all the property affected and that will be affected by the vacation of that part of Hall Street above described; that the particular circumstances justifying the vacation of said street between said blocks are -

(a) That the described part of Hall Street is unnecessary to the public use or to any use, because of the fact that there is no public crossing and none is contemplated across the railroad track at said place, and the distance between Jefferson Avenue and the railroad right of way is merely the distance of the length of the lots, said railroad right of way at said point being fenced and enclosed by the railroad company in accordance with state law;

(b) That the said part of Hall Street has never been and is not now used in any manner for any purpose by or for the public, but since its dedication has been unused by the public and unused by anyone to or for any useful purpose, and no one can or will be benefited by the maintenance of said part of Hall Street as a public street or way.

That a particular description of the street to be vacated is as follows: All that part of Hall Street extending from the Northeasterly side of Jefferson Avenue to the Southwest boundary line of the O-W.R & N. Company's right of way, which part of Hall Street lies between Lot 11, Block 3, and Lot 1, Block 4, of "Carr's Subdivision of Blocks 13 and 14 of Honan's Addition to the City of La Grande, Union County, Oregon."

That the names of the persons particularly affected

by the vacating of that part of Hall Street above described are as follows: Fletcher Oil Company, a corporation, Maude M. Johnson, and Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, a corporation;

That the petitioners present with this petition the consent in writing of the abutting and adjoining property owners to the vacation of said described portion of Hall Street, which is without the city limits of the city of La Grande, Oregon, and is located in platted and subdivided tracts of acreage outside the limits of an incorporated city, to wit, said city of La Grande, Oregon.

WHEREFORE, petitioners pray that a time be fixed for hearing on this petition, and that after such hearing an order be made closing and vacating the described portion of Hall Street and vacating the platting thereof, after taking such action and giving such notice as is required in such cases.



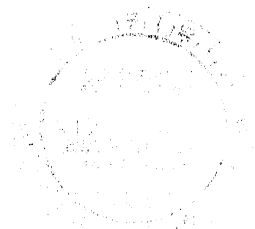



Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned until Thursday, April 2nd, 1931, at 9:00 o'clock, A.M.

And it further appearing that the Bureau of Biological Survey is ready to commence work within Union County as soon as the county's appropriation has been paid,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the County Clerk be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant in favor of Hal E. Hoss, Secretary of State, in the sum of \$410.00 to be used in the control of predatory animals within Union County.

ORDER VACATING STREET

Whereas, on the 31st day of March, 1931, a petition was filed with this court asking for the vacation of the following described street, to-wit: that part of Hall street extending from the Northeasterly side of Jefferson Avenue to the Southwest boundary line of the O-W R & N Company's right of way, which part of Hall Street lies between Lot 11, Block 3, and Lot 1, Block 4, of Carr's Subdivision of Blocks 13 and 14 of Honan's Addition to the city of La Grande, Union County, Oregon, by Fletcher Oil Company, a corporation, Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, a corporation, and Maude M. Johnson, owners in fee simple of all the property adjoining, adjacent and abutting on that part of Hall Street above described, together with their written consent to the vacation of said street; and

Whereas said petition was in proper form, and set forth the particular circumstances of the case, and gives a distinct description of the property to be vacated, and the persons particularly affected thereby, to-wit, said petitioners; that said petition was filed with the County Clerk of Union County, Oregon, more than thirty days previous to this sitting of the County Court; and

Whereas on the first day of April, 1931, an order was made by this court fixing the time and place for hearing said petition and any objections thereto, at ten o'clock, A.M., on the 7th day of May, 1931, at the County Court Room in the Courthouse in La Grande, Union County, Oregon, which order further required the County Clerk to issue notice of the pendency of said petition, requiring all persons having objections to the vacating of that part of Hall Street above described to file same with the County Clerk of Union County, Oregon, on or before Thursday, the 7th day of May, 1931, at ten A.M., and directing the Sheriff to post three copies of the Clerk's notice issued pursuant to said order; and

Whereas it is made to appear by the affidavit of Jesse Breshears, Sheriff of Union County, Oregon, that a notice in due form as required by the order of this court was on April 1, 1931, duly issued by the County Clerk of said county, copies of which notice were by said Sheriff posted in three of the most public and conspicuous places within the

limits of the above described platted acreage, to-wit: one on a telephone pole at the extreme easterly end of that part of Hall Street sought to be vacated; one on a telephone pole at the extreme westerly end of that part of Hall Street sought to be vacated, and one on the telephone pole at the intersection of Hall Street with Adams Avenue extended, or the Old Oregon Trail; that one copy of such notice was posted by said sheriff at the front door of the courthouse in La Grande, Union County, Oregon; all on the first day of April, 1931, and

Whereas at this hour of ten o'clock AM, on the 7th day of May, 1931, the court did meet at its court room in La Grande, Union County, Oregon, and canvassed and ascertained and determined that no objections have been filed or made in writing or otherwise to the County Clerk of Union County, Oregon, or to this court, objecting to the granting of said petition, on or before the time fixed in said order or otherwise or at all; and

Whereas it seems meet and proper that said petition should be allowed, and no good reason appears for disallowing the same;

Therefore, in allowance of said petition, it is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that there is here now vacated, and the same shall no longer be a public street, highway or thoroughfare, the following described street, to-wit:

That part of Hall Street extending from the Northeasterly side of Jefferson Avenue to the Southwest boundary line of the O-W R R & N Company's right of way, which part of Hall Street lies between Lot 11, Block 3, and Lot 1, Block 4, of Carr's Sub-division of Blocks 13 and 14 of Honan's Addition to the city of La Grande, Union County, Oregon.

Thereupon the Journal of today's proceedings was read, approved, and is here now signed, and it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term.
