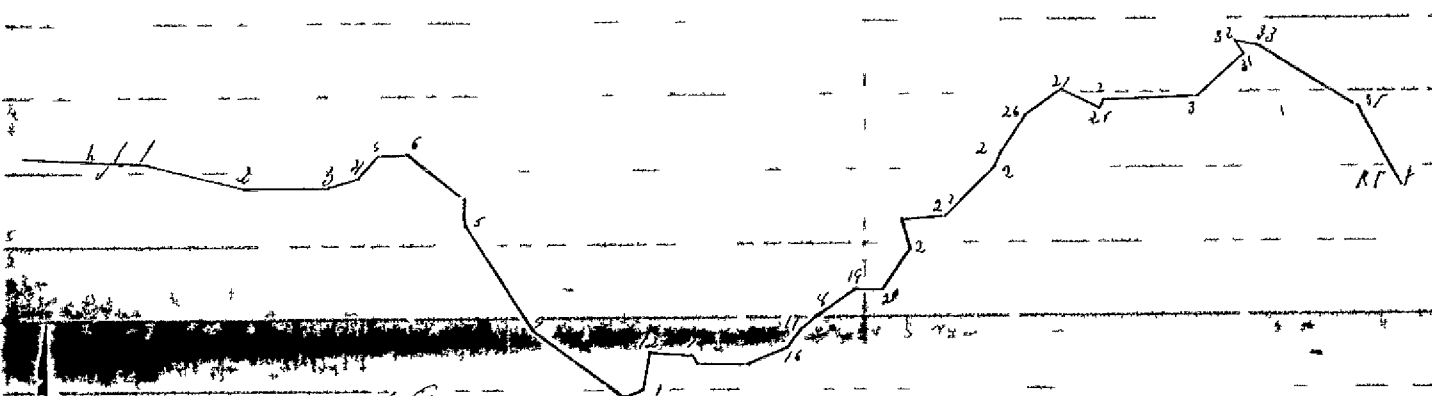

We, the undersigned
resident householders of Union County Oregon
respectfully petition your Honorable Body
to view, survey, and locate a County road
as follows: Commencing about one eighth
of a mile due south ^{of the center} of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S 20,
T 4 S R 40 E, and running thence in an
easterly direction about one & one half mile,
to the mouth of the Canyon coming into
July Ann Creek from the South, in which
is now a wagon road used as a timber road:

~~Thence up said Canyon to Camas Prairie~~
thence ^{northerly} about 40 rods,
thence in an easterly direction, ⁱⁿ directly over
the divide and down the North side of what
is known as the 'saddle' or Ames Hill to
the mouth of Dry Canyon in High Valley,
thence up said Canyon about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile,
thence, leaving said Canyon and running
in an easterly direction to a Cove in the
base of the mountain East of High Valley,
thence up said mountain to a Point about
40 rods above 'The Spring' on said mountain,
terminating at said Point; all of which of said
points are in Union County Oregon.

Whereas a petition has been presented to the County Court of Union County Oregon at the Jan term thereof for 1876 for a County Road commencing about one eighth of a mile due south of the center of the N E 4 of S 20 T. 4 S R. 40 E., and running thence Eastward about 1/2 mile to the mouth of a Canyon coming into Julia Ann Creek from the South, thence up said Canyon to Carnas Prairie thence Eastward to Dry Canyon in High Valley, thence up said Canyon about 1/4 of a mile thence leaving said Canyon and running Eastward to the base of the mountain East of High Valley, thence up said Mountain to a point about 1/2 mile above the Spring on said Mountain.

Now therefore I W. A. Carter hereby agree to pay to the County of Union the sum of One hundred dollars. The condition of the above obligation is such that if the prayers of the said petitioners be not granted, then I will pay all costs and expenses that may be incurred by reason of such view, otherwise to be null and void.

Now on this day was read the first time the report of the viewers made Dec 20th 1875 on the Proposed Road from Haughtons Bridge to Goose Creek.

Now on this day was presented the following Road Petition.

To the Hon County Court of Union County Oregon.
We the resident householders of Union County Oregon respectfully petition your Hon body to view, survey and locate a county Road, as follows.
Commencing about one eighth of a mile due south of the center of the N E 1/4 of Sec 20 T 4 S R 40 E and running thence in an easterly direction, about about one and one half mile to the mouth of the Canyon coming into July Ann Creek from the south in which is now a wagon Road used as a timber road; thence up said Canyon to Gannas Prairie, thence northerly, about 40 rods, thence in an easterly direction, indirectly over the divide and down the north side of what is known as the Saddle or Ames hill to the mouth of dry canyon in High Valley; thence up said canyon, about 3/4 of a mile; thence leaving said canyon, and running in an easterly direction to a cove in the base of the Mountain East of high valley; thence up said Mountain to a point about 40 rods above the spring on said Mountain terminating at said point, all of which of said points are in Union County Oregon.

The above Petition was accompanied by an Affidavit by W. A. Bates that he had posted four notices that the above Petition would be presented, that they were posted more than 30 days prior to this Term of Court, one on the Court house door, one at the commencement of said Road, one at the terminus, & one along the line, and there being a bond filed to pay all costs in case said Road is not established & it appearing that there is more than 12 resident householders signing said petition and that the same has been proceeded with according to law. It is therefore ordered that Willis Skiff Surveyor meet Wm Hutchinson: Blaine Ashby & J. A. Clark as viewers at the house of A. C. Cook on Saturday Jan 15th 1876 at 10 o'clock A.M. of said day. Said viewers to view out, survey & report on the practicability of said proposed Road.

No further business appearing the court adjourned until to morrow morning, at 9 o'clock

Due Proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of
Road Petition

Now, at this time came Andrew Wilkinson who presents to the Court the Petition of himself, and 30 others paying for the view, survey and location, of a proposed County Road, as follows to wit:

Commencing about $\frac{1}{8}$ of a mile, due South of the center of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 20 T. 4. S. R. 40 E., and running thence in an easterly direction, along the South side of the farms of Osbe Bates and A LaBuff, thence from the farm of A. LaBuff up the bed of the Canyon through which Julian Creek now runs, to where the County Road running from Coor to Big-Creek crosses said creek which is about 3 miles from the starting point, from thence in an easterly direction over the hill to what is known as dry gulch, thence up said gulch about one quarter of a mile, thence in a southerly direction until it strikes the timber Road, about one quarter of a mile below the spring on said, thence along said timber Road to said spring, which will be the terminus of said proposed Road.

And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court from proof filed herein, that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required: that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders residing in the vicinity of said Road, and

a good and sufficient bond has been filed. It is therefore ordered by the Court that L. A. Blacker, Davd Johnson and E. B. Hiltz be appointed viewers and Willis Skiff Surveyor to view, survey and report upon said proposed road and that they meet at the house of A. C. Cook on the 13th day of April 1876., and, duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

Road Viewers Report }

Now on this day, read for the 3rd time the report of the Viewers on the Road or proposed road commencing at a post marked B in Sec 2 Town 1 North. Range 40 East thence across Grande Ronde River to intersect the County road leading from Summerville through Indian Valley, and the report being favorable and there being no remonstrance or petition for damages laid in. It is therefore ordered that said County Road be established in accordance with the Plat of the Survey which is, as follows.
