is useless as a part of the general road system of Union County and is burdensome to maintain, and that the land adjacent to said portion of said road is owned by Grande Ronde Reservoir Company; and

WHEREAS, the public will be benefited by the vacation of said portion of said road, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that such proceedings as are required by law to vacate said above described road will be undertaken.


I therefore recommend that the said portion of the road No. 360 be closed as a public highway of Union County, Oregon.

In the Matter of the exchange of certain lands of the Grande Ronde Pine Company for National Forest timber within the Whitman National Forest

ORDER

WHEREAS, the Grande Ronde Pine Company has offered to exchange 23,594.77 acres of land in its ownership within and adjacant to the Whitman National Forest for National Forest timber located within the same National Forest under the Act of March 20, 1922, (42 Stat. 465), as amended by the Acts of February 28, 1925 (43 Stat. 1090), March 4, 1925 (43 Stat. 1282), and June 17, 1940 (Public No. 638): and,

WHEREAS, the Act of June T7, 1940 (Public No.638) provides that any lands within the area described by said Act may be acquired through exchange only if the Board of County Commissioners of the county or counties in which said lands are situated approves the exchange; and

WHEREAS, certain lands in T. 5S., R. 40 E., T. 5S., R. 41 E., T. 5 S., R. 42 E., and T. 6 S., R. 41 E., W. M., all in Union County, are included in the hereinabove-described exchange; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Court that the consummation of the above-described exchange between the Grande Ronde Pine Company and the United States of America is in the best interests of the public;

Now, Therefore, it is hereby ORDERED: That the County Court of Union County, Oregon, in regular session on this 3rd day of June, 1943, approve the exchange of the lands of the Grande Ronde Pine Company within T. 5 S., R. 40 E., T. 5S., R. 41 E., T. 5 S., R. 42 E., and T. 6 S., R. 41 E. W. M., and including in the hereinabove-described exchange offer,

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this approval by the County Court of Union County is adopted to meet the requirements of the Act of June 17, 1940 (Public No.638).
