Now at this time came August Shaw and presents a Petition of himself and 30 others living in the vicinity of the hereinafter proposed County Road, and asks the court to ~~show~~ a County Road established, commencing at the south end of Jefferson Street in Summerville, thence running west, along the present traveled road as nearly as practicable to a point intersecting the Trimble and Galbraith County road one and three fourths mile from the place of commencing, and said petition being accompanied by proof of notices having been posted according to law, & a bond for costs of survey in case said road ~~is~~ will not be granted, and it appearing to the court that the Petitioners herein have proceeded according to law, it is therefore ordered that Roderick McKimsey, Wm German and J. P. Woodell be, and they are hereby appointed viewers, and Willis Skiff Surveyor to meet at Summerville in said Co on the 24th day of March 1876 and after being duly sworn proceed to view, survey and report to this court at its next Term, the practicability of said road.

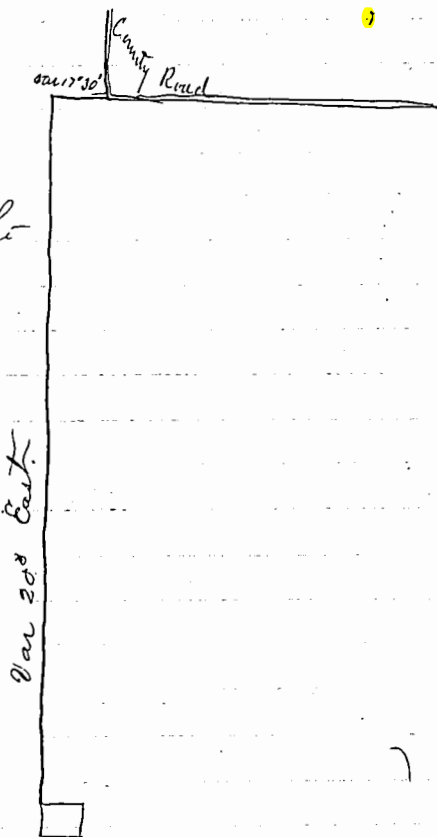
