E. corner of Sec 4 & equidistant from the E. line of Sec 4 thence due N 1/4 mile - thence E 1/4 mile, on Sec line - thence due N 1/2 mile on Sec line, thence E 1/4 mile - thence due N to Empress Creek - thence on the most practicable route to Gravelly Saw Mill & your petitioners will ever pray &c.
