The law requires that the application shall be signed by at least 12 householders of the county, residing in the vicinity when the proposed road is to be laid out.

The Petition in this case is by 12 householders & citizens and others of the Walla Walla Valley Winn Co. Oregon.

In this respect the Petition is defective, but I think if it can be shown that the persons signing the petition, do reside in the vicinity of the road it is sufficient.

There is nothing accompanying the paper to show that Acta nos posse as required by law. This is necessary.

The Petition is not filed in court and is not part of the record until it is so filed.

Whereas a petition has been presented
by the Citizens of Willawa Valley for a
County Road to Ammoniac at the
Temple of the County Road known
as the County Road and ending
at the School House in Upper Willawa
Valley. Now therefore I
John McCally am held and firmly
bound to Union County Oregon
in the Sum of Five Hundred Dollars,
Conditioned that if said Road be
granted and allowed by said County
Court, then this obligation to be null
and void, but if not allowed, then
I will pay all costs and expenses
that may be incurred by reason
of such Survey not exceeding five hundred dollars

Court met pursuant to adjournment

Same Officers present as on yesterday.

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of Location of
County Road by petition

On this day came John McCall who presents to the Court the petition of himself and thirty one others, praying for the view, survey and location of a County Road commencing at the Terminus of a proposed road leading in Indian Valley known as the Owenbey Road, thence to the Junction of the Minnenum and Wallowa Rivers, thence up the Willowa River to Wallowa Valley, thence to fort Sturgill, thence to Long ford, thence to upper Wallowa School house, thence to Silver Lake

And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court from proof filed herein, that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said petitioners are legal householders residing in the vicinity of said road, and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed, which bond has been approved by the Court.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that Robert Cochran, Andrew Harris, and William Hebbel be appointed Viewers, and Willis Stoff Surveyor, to view, survey and report upon said proposed road, and that they meet at the house of William Smith on the 15th day of June 1876, and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge their duties in this behalf.

Keville has passed the proper examination and it further appearing that the quota of Schollships from this County is not yet filled. it is therefore ordered by the Court that James M. Keville be & hereby is selected by the Court, as entitled to gratuitous tuition in the State University.
