

Survey

To the Hon. County Court of Union
County, Oregon.

The following report is respectfully
submitted by us the undersigned viewers appointed
to view out and locate a proposed change in the
County road leading from La Grand to Union.

We failed to meet on the day set but on
the second day thereafter (the 9th day of Oct. 1876)
we met only two viewers being present and after
first being sworn, in company with the surveyor
proceeded to view, survey and lay out said proposed
change of road as directed and as shown by the surveyors
report and plat submitted herewith. We find
the distance by the new route $130\frac{1}{2}$ chains and in the
old road as now ~~is~~ traveled $142\frac{1}{2}$ chains, making a
difference of 12 chains in favor of the new route.
The nature of the ground is nearly the same on
both lines of road. Taking into consideration the
benefits to the settlement by allowing this change
it is our opinion that the prayer of the petitioners
is reasonable, and we would further recommend
the extension of this change toward the West
to intersect the La Grand and Luddy Canyon
road a distance of about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile from the
terminus of the above change.

Now on this day came Archie Little who presents to the Court the Petition of himself and Fourteen others praying for a change in the County Road leading from Galbraude to Union; Change Commencing at a point on said Road due south of the dwelling house known as the old Russell house, now owned by Taylor Green and running due west to intersect the new County Road leading from near the fair grounds to the mouth of Ladd Canyon and to vacate all the County road which lies between the commencement and the terminus of the above described route. And it satisfactorily appearing to the Court from proof filed herein, that due notice of the pendency of this proceeding has been given as by law required; that more than twelve of said Petitioners are resident householders of Union County residing in the vicinity of said proposed change, and that a good and sufficient bond has been filed herein, which bond is approved by the Court.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that George Beckler, John Howard and Arthur Hemming be appointed Viewers and Willis Skiff, Surveyor to view Survey and report upon said road and that they meet at the old dwelling house of Taylor Green known as the old Russell house on Saturday the 7th day of Oct-1876 and duly qualify before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

at this time was taken in consideration the report of the viewers on the proposed change of the County Road leading from LaGrande to Union said report stating that the proposed change would make said Road shorter but it appearing from the Official plat of said change that the distance would be increased & from evidence submitted that said change would be a detriment to the travelling public & of no public utility It is therefor ordered that said change be not granted & that further proceedings herein be not had.
