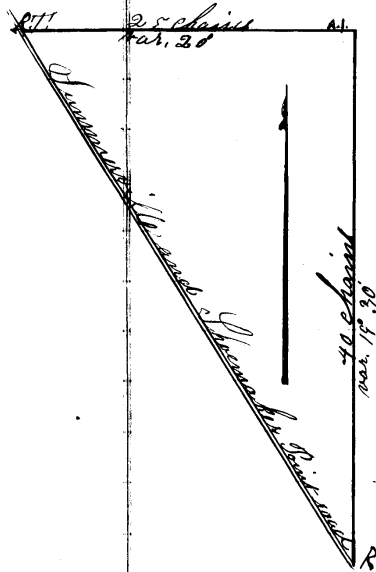

of locating a proposed change in the

Thence West to intersect the County road
leading from Summerville to Chermakess
Point

We ~~failed to meet~~ ^{met} on the day named in
your order but on the account of the absence
of the Surveyor we adjourned to meet
on the 29th day of March 1877. at which
time we met only two viewers being
present. After first being duly
sworn in company with the
surveyor we proceeded to view survey
and layout said change as directed
and as shown by the surveyors
plot and report, submitted herewith
we find the distance on the proposed
road to be 260 rods and the road as
now traveled 170 rods. Taken in consider-
ation the benefit^{ts} of the owners of the land
through which the road is now located
and the small inconvenience ^{to} ~~to~~ public

 who presents to the Court the petition
 of himself and others praying for an
 Alteration to made in the Summerville
 and Shoemaker County Road, said
 Alteration to commence at the South
 East corner of the North East-quarter
 of Sec 30 T. 1. S. R. 39 E and running
 thence North $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the South East
 corner of Sec 20 of said Range, thence
 West $\frac{1}{4}$ mile there intersecting the above
 named road.
 And said petition being signed by
 more than 12 resident-householders
 of said County living in the vicinity
 of said proposed Alteration, and proof
 of notice of the pendency of this proceed-
 ing having been duly given, and
 the petitioners herein having filed
 a good & sufficient bond to pay all
 costs in case said Alteration is
 not effected upon said petition which
 bond is approved by the Court.
 it is therefore ordered that Samuel
 Booth; B. S. Halley and William
 Probstel be appointed receivers and
 Willis Skiff Surveyor, who are to meet
 at the Sand Ridge School house on the
 26th day of March and after being
 duly sworn proceed to view Survey &
 report on the practicability of said

It is therefore ordered that said change be allowed in accordance with the Plat. of the survey thereof a copy of which is Recended on the 106 page of this Book.
