the 14th day of April 1877, and after
being duly sworn proceeded to view
and relocate the Road above mentioned
and relocated the same in accordance
with the Surveyors Plat hereto
attached and submitted herewith
and we recommend that the said
Road be established in accordance
therewith, all of which is
respectfully submitted.

April 2nd 1877 At a Special term of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Union begun and held at the Court house in Union in said County on Monday the 2nd day of April AD 1877, there was present Hon E. C. Brainard, County Judge, F. T. Dick Co. Commissioner S. O. Swackhamer Sheriff and R. J. Cates County Clerk.

Due Proclamation of the opening of Court having been made the following proceedings were had to wit:

In the matter of review and Survey of the County Road leading from Union to intersect the County Road from Galswood to Ladder Canyon } April 3rd

Now at this time it appearing to the Court that the beginning of the above described County Road has become uncertain by reason of the removal of the stakes and monuments that hereto designated said road by reason of which a portion of said is being obstructed by fencing the same.

It is therefore ordered and decreed that W. T. Ficklin; Joseph Shambaugh and Jackson Ficklin be and they are hereby appointed to review, and if deemed necessary to straighten, or to place said Road on better or more practical ground, said viewers to meet in Union on the 11th day of April 1877 and after being qualified as by law required, proceed with Willis Skiff as surveyor, to review, Survey and locate said County Road, and make due report of their proceedings herein to this Court on or before the ~~11th~~ Monday in May 1877, that being the 1st day of Commissioners Court for May Term 1877.

May 23rd Ninth Judicial day May 23rd 1877

Court met pursuant to adjournment.

Same officers present as on yesterday

Due proclamation of the opening of Court having been made. The record of yesterdays proceedings was read, approved and is now signed.

Thereupon the Court adjourned to following business

In the matter of Viewers Report } Union to Balgrand & Ladd Canyon
County Road.

Now at this time came on for hearing the Report of the Viewers on the location and strategizing of the County Road leading from Union to Balgrand & Ladd Canyon County Road,

And said viewers submitted with their Report a Plat of the survey made according to location of said road, and recommends that the same be entered as the correct description of said road.

And it was ordered by the Court that the same be permanently located according to said Plat of which the following is a correct copy.

To W. D. Ficklin and Jack Fickle viewers appointed to Review the County Road from Union thence to intersect the Balgrand and Ladd Canyon County Road.
