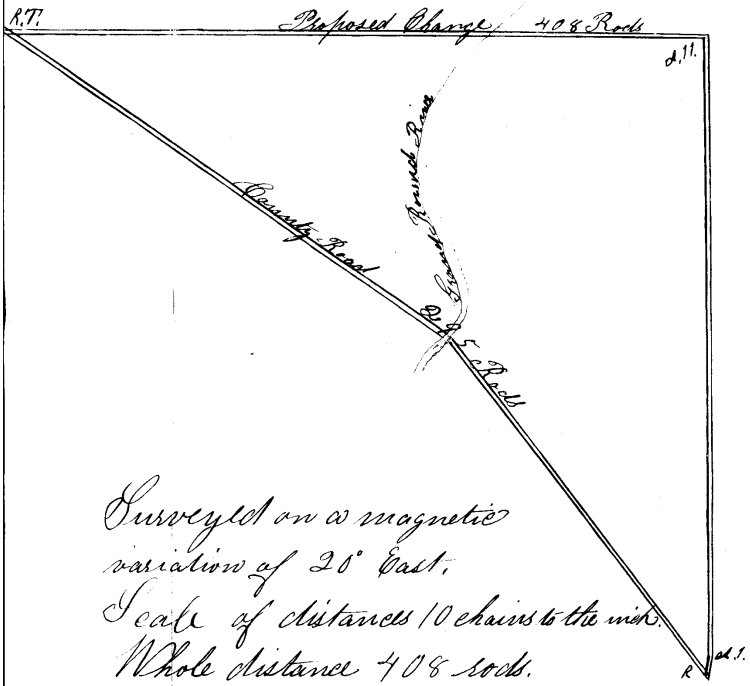

appointed viewers and Willis Skiff Surveyor

proposed change at the May Term of this
Court

 the report of the viewers appointed to
 view & report the practicability of
 changing the county road leading from
 Union to Summerville via Henderson
 point said change to commence at
 or near the center of Section 7 T. 3. S.
 of Range 40 East, and described in
 full on page 104 of this Journal in
 the appointment of viewers,

The viewers having met according to the
 order of this Court & after viewing &
 duly considering said proposed change
 recommend that the same be not made.
 It was therefore ordered that said
 road be remain as the same now is
 and that no change therein be made
 & that the petition be dismissed from
 further consideration and that the
 Bondsman herein pay all costs of
 such view and survey.
