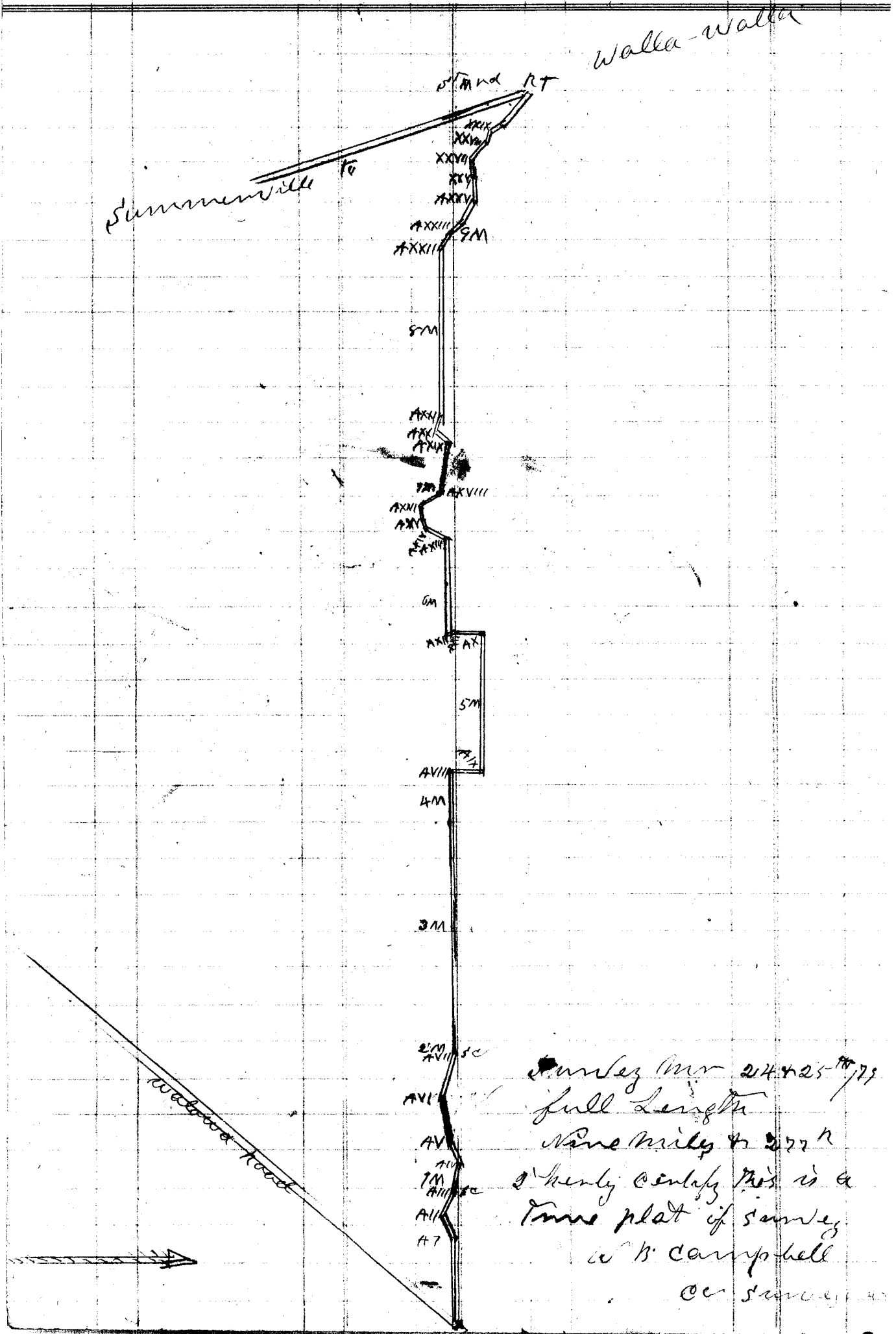

a proposed County road from the terminus of what
is known as the Ownby road thence through the
Willow Country.

We met on the 18th day of July the day
named in your order but owing to high water we adjourned
to meet on the 10th day of Oct.

Pursuant to adjournment we met on the 10th day of
Oct. 1877 and after being first duly sworn in company
with the surveyor proceeded to view, survey and lay out
said road as directed and as shown by the surveyors
report submitted herewith. We have located the road
on the only practicable route to connect with Grand
Round valley and although it will require some
heavy grading to build the road through what is
known as the Willow Canyon it will not be an
expensive road to ^{build} considering the distance run. ~~and~~
Taking into consideration the benefits to the settlers

by the opening up of this road and also to others wishing
to settle. It is our opinion that the road ought
to be granted and all reasonable aid extended
to open the road as soon as possible.

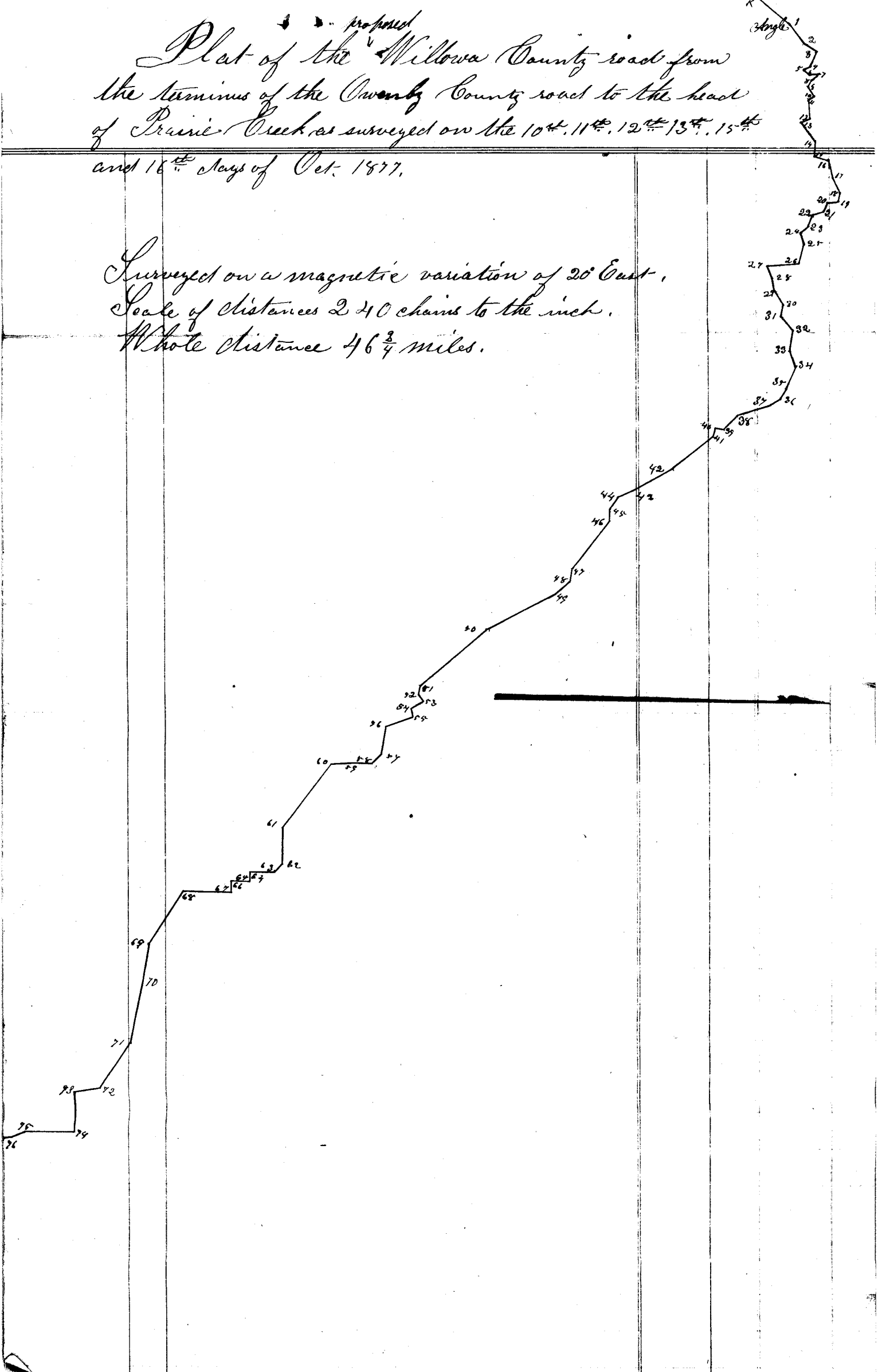

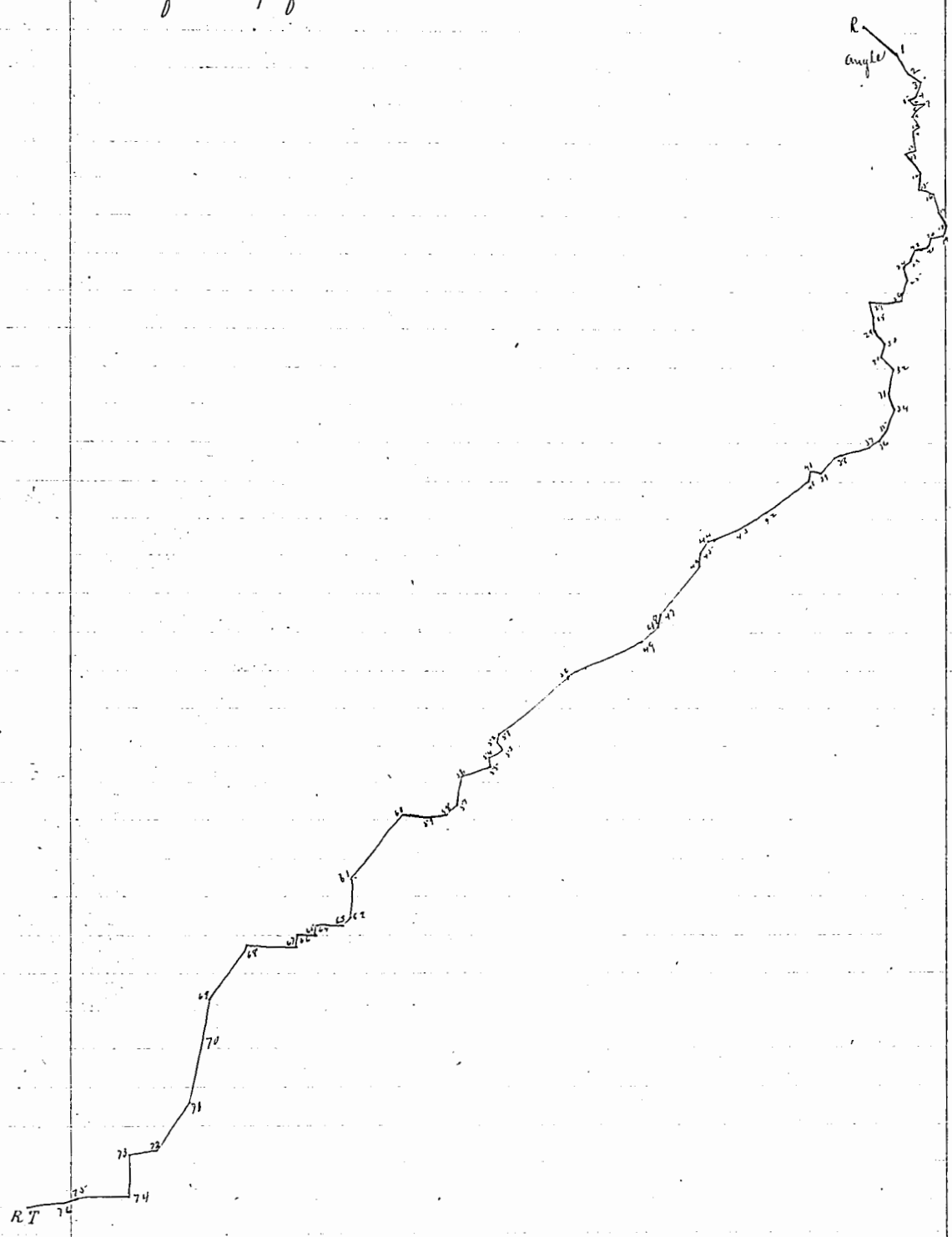
