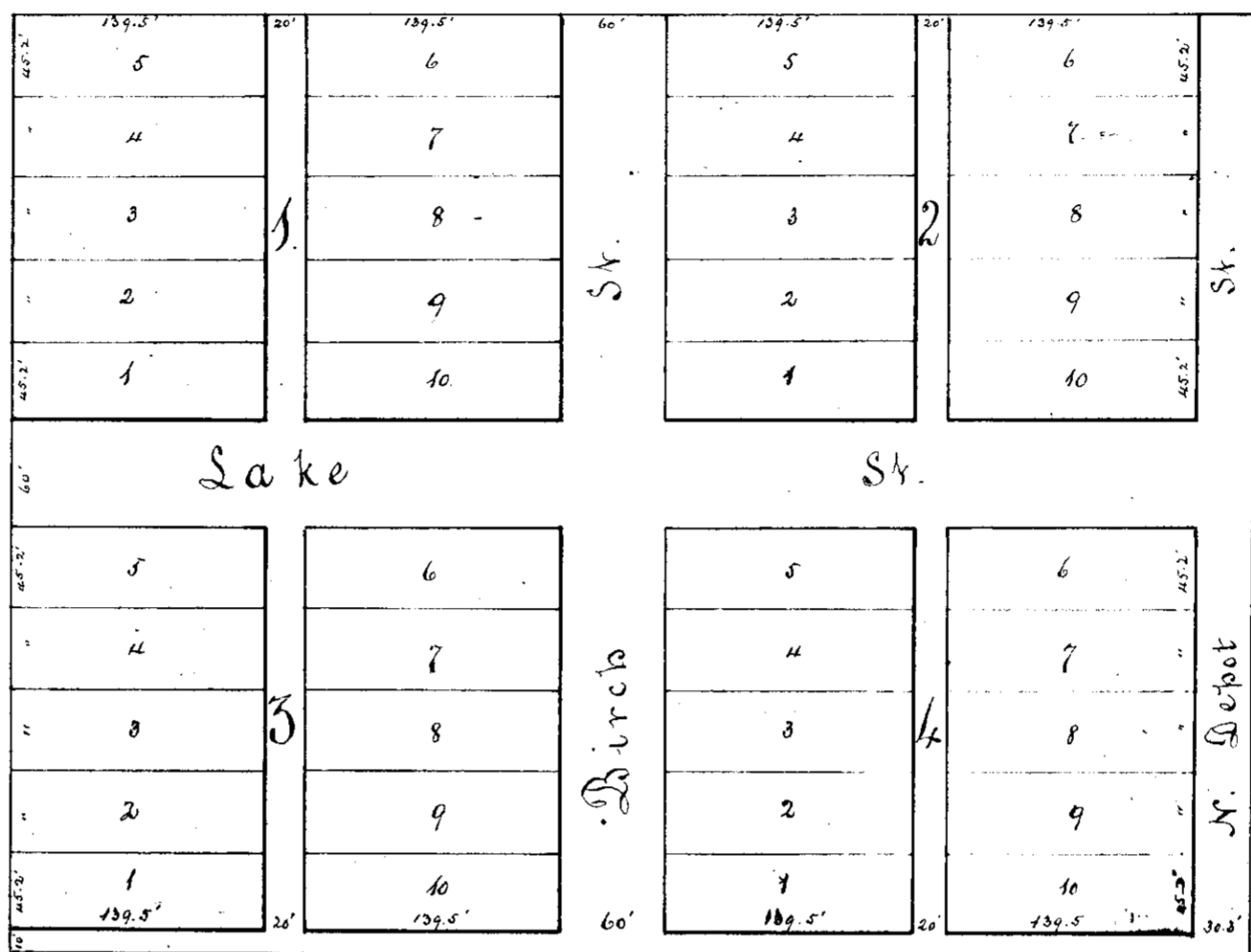
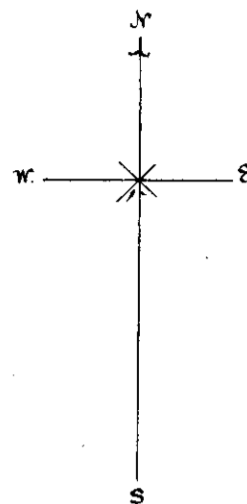


DWIGHT'S ADDITION.

To all to whom these Presents shall come greeting: Know ye that we H. H. Dwight and Emily Dwight, husband and wife are the owners of the following described real estate, to-wit: Commencing at the south east corner of the south west quarter of the south west quarter section thirty two, township two south of range thirty eight east of the Willamette Meridian in Union County, Oregon and at a Stone Monument running thence west six hundred and eighty eight and 3/10 (688.3) feet, thence North Five hundred and twenty two feet (522) feet, thence east six hundred and eighty eight and 3/10 (688.3) feet, thence south five hundred and twenty two feet (522) to the place of beginning all in Union County, Oregon. And that we have surveyed and platted the same for the purpose of sale, named and to be known as Dwight's Addition to La Grande Union County Oregon, and we do now declare and acknowledge the attached plat and map to be a true plat and survey thereof that the streets alleys blocks and lots thereof are of the size and width therein named and shown and numbered and we do hereby dedicate to the public the streets and alleys therein shown as public easements as provided by law.
