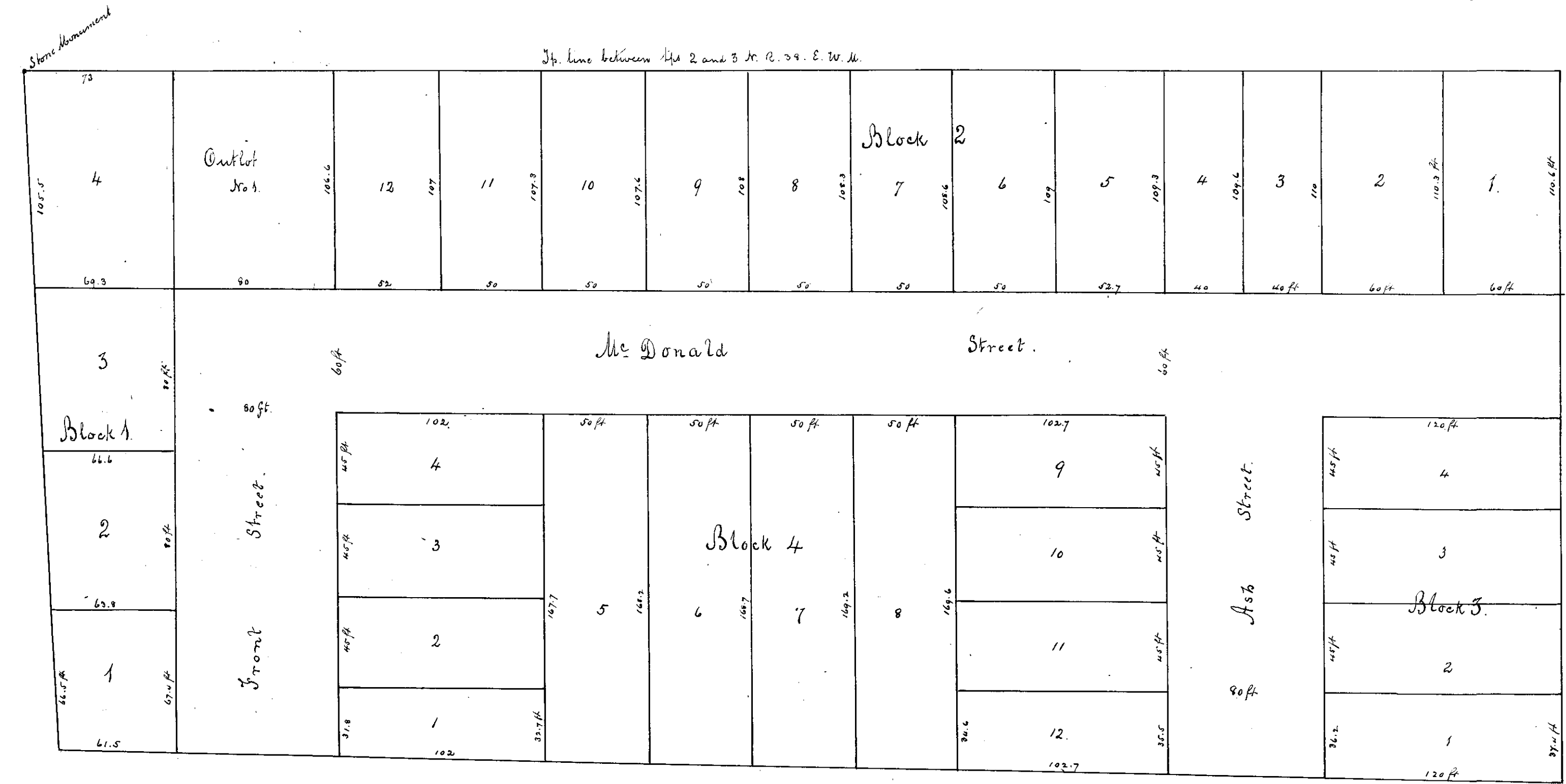


HELSON'S ADDITION,

County of Union: Personally appeared before the undersigned J. L. Heidenreich Notary Public for Oregon, on this 2nd day of July A. D. 1890. Walter Helson and Annie Helson his wife personally known to me who acknowledged to me that they surveyed laid out and platted all that parcel of land lying and situate in the North West 1/4 of Sec. 5 in Township 3 South of Range 38 E. W. M. in Union County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the North West corner of said Sec. 5 Twp. and Range aforesaid, thence running along said section and township line East 757.7 feet, thence South 381.5 feet, thence West 746.2 feet, thence North 335.9 to place of beginning, in town lots, blocks and alleys, and that the plat upon which this acknowledgment and certificate is placed is the original and true plat of said survey and land so laid out, that they hereby dedicate the blocks and alleys thereon represented, as required by law and that the same is their voluntary act and deed which acknowledgment of Annie Helson the wife was made separate and apart from her husband Walter Helson.
