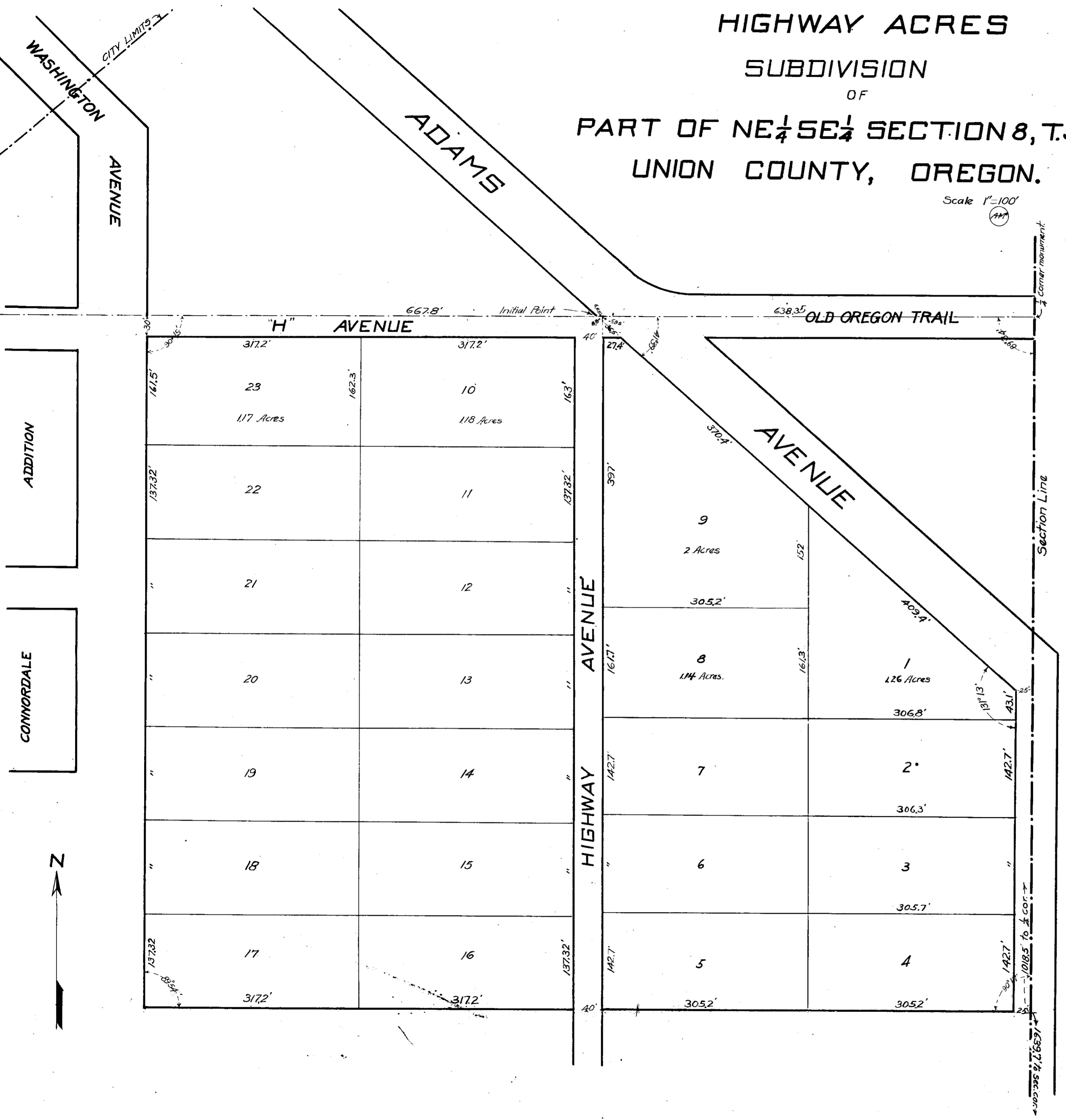


HIGHWAY ACRES
