


Map of

All streets are 50 feet wide except 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th blocks and Grace Street, which are 60 feet wide. All blocks are 200 feet square except blocks 1, 2, 3 & 4.

The same to remain such streets as herein marked and designated unto the public for streets forever, and they each acknowledged to me that executed the same freely and voluntarily for the uses and purposes herein expressed.
