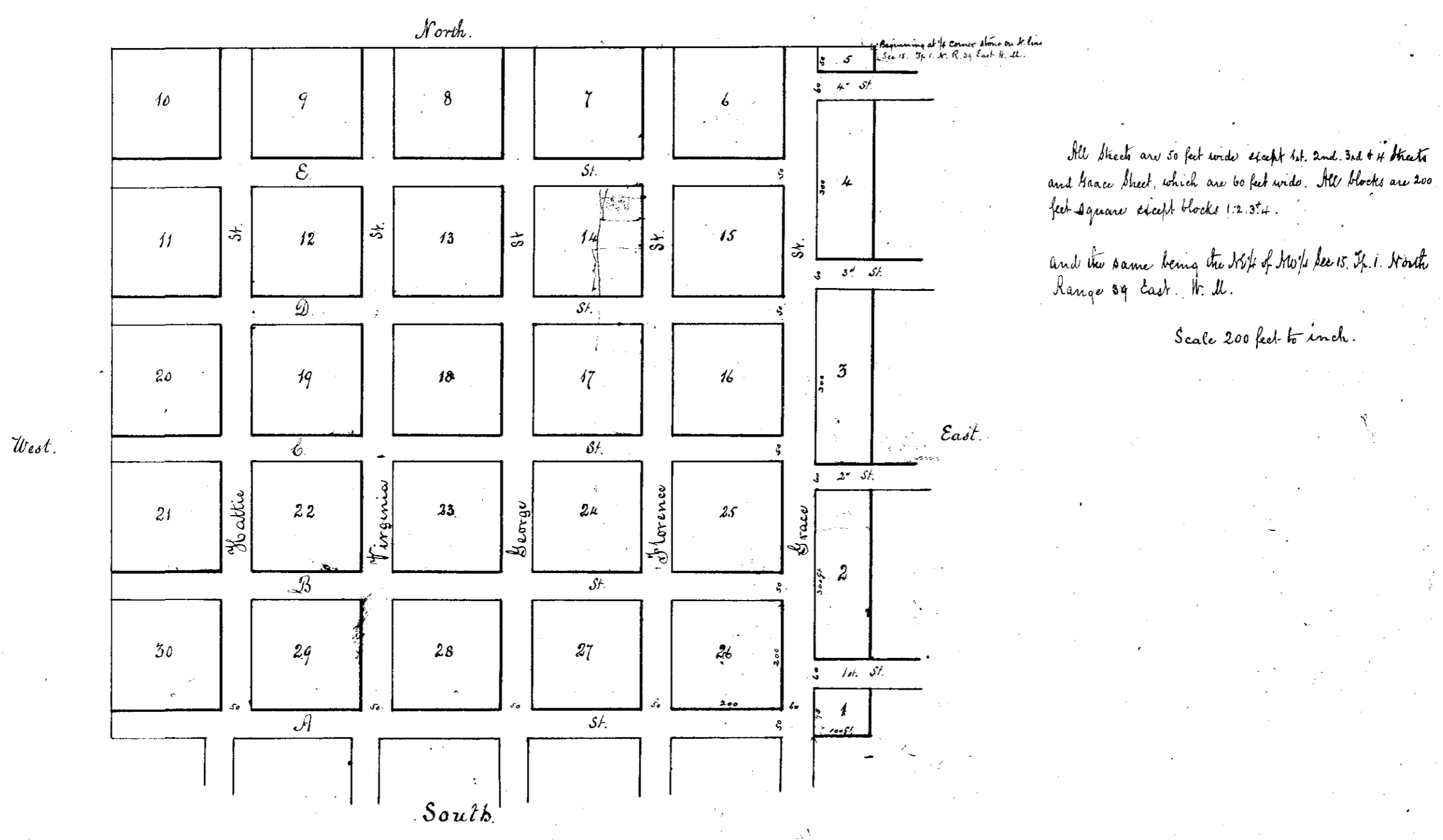


Map of

 streets, also A, B, C, D & E streets. The same to remain such streets as hereon marked and designated unto the public for streets forever, and they each acknowledged to me
 that they executed the same freely and voluntarily for the uses and purposes herein expressed. Witness my hand and seal this 15th day of May 1891.
