


STEVENSON'S ADDITION,
to Elgin, Or.

Stevenson's Addition to Elgin is situated in that part of the North half of the South East 1/4 of Section 15 Township 1 North of Range 39 East of the Will. Mts. as follows: commencing at a stone marked T at a point 23.53 chains North and 13.53 chains East from the south west corner. Hence north 12.42 chains to a stone marked T hence East 4.52 chains to a stone marked T at the North west corner of the Town site of Elgin, hence South 7.57 chains to a stone marked T hence East 14.50 chains to a stone marked T at the South East corner of the Town site of Elgin hence south 4.95 chains to a stone marked T hence West 19.09 chains to the place of beginning containing 12.66 acres. Magnetic Variation 20° East. All lots are 60x120. The streets are 60 feet wide. The alleys are 20 feet wide.
