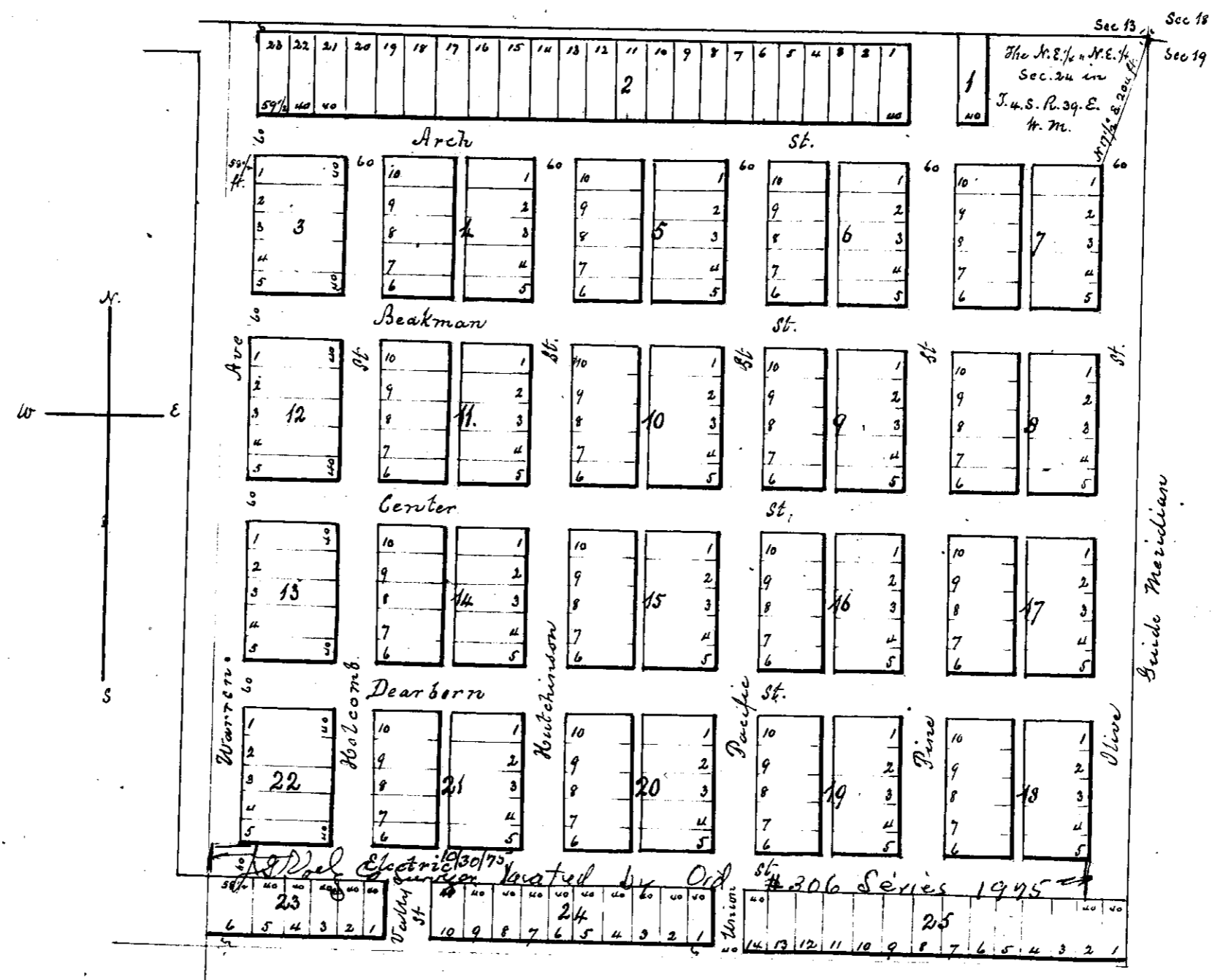


UNION RAILWAY ADDITION,

W. M.; embracing all of said tract, except a lot in the N.E. corner thereof, 135 feet in width north and south, by 250 feet in length east and west.

Know all men by these presents, that the Union Railway Company, a Corporation duly incorporated and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, whose Office and principal place of business is at Union in said County and State, being the owner of the land platted and described by said Corporation upon the above map, as the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 24, Township 4 South, of Range 39, East of the Willamette Meridian; except a lot in the North East corner thereof, 135 feet in width North and South, by 250 feet in length East and West; platted as the Union Railway Addition to the Town of West Union; do hereby dedicate to public use, the parts and parcels thereof represented and marked thereon, as Streets and Alleys; reserving to itself the right to build, construct and operate its said Railway upon said streets. In witness whereof said Company has hereunto set its Official signature and sealed the same with scroll, the Co having no private seal.
