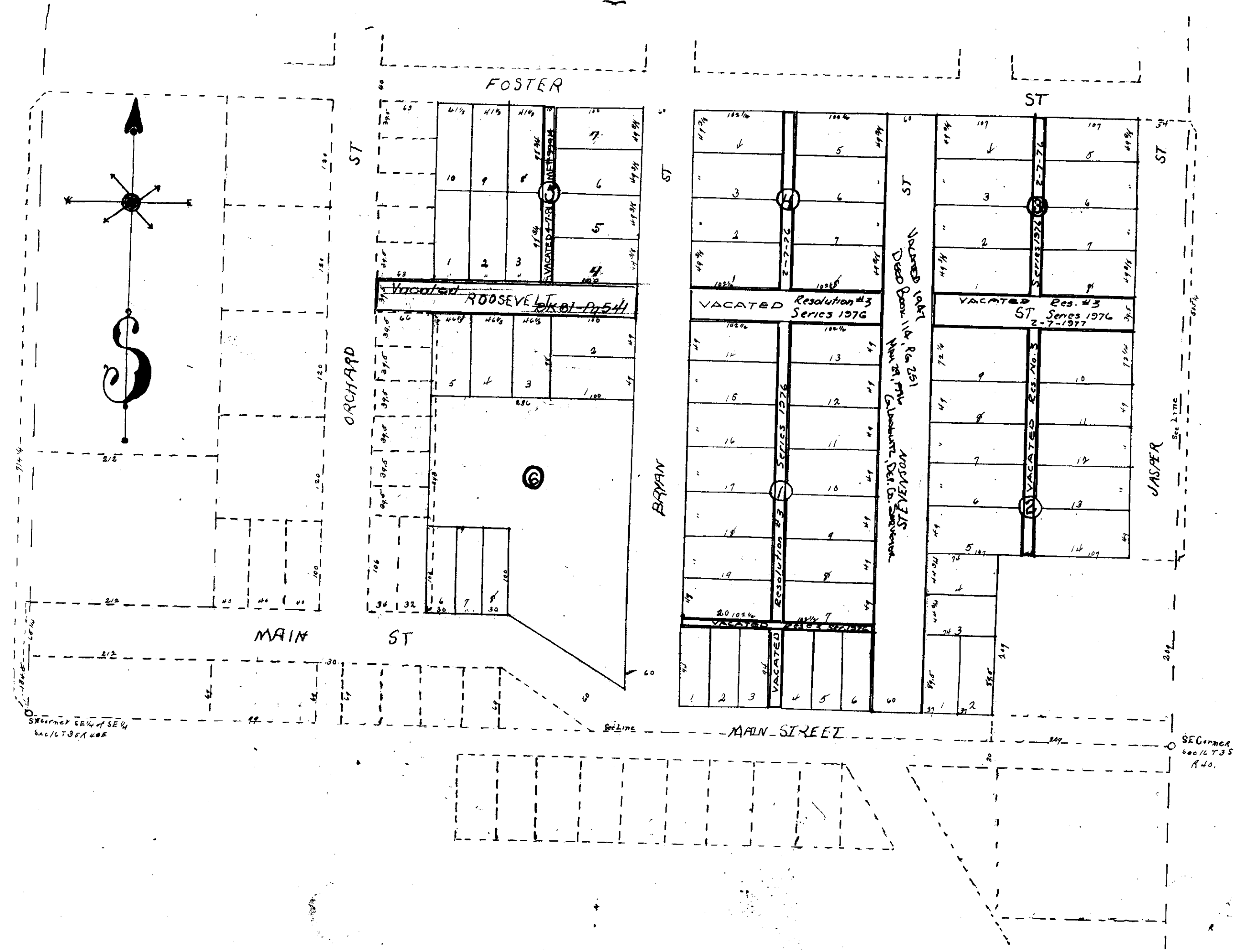


WILBUR'S ADDITION

Know all men by these presents, that we, John P. Wilbur and Emma Wilbur, his wife, of Union County, Oregon, being owners of the lands surveyed and plotted in Wilbur's Addition to the Town of Groves, Union County, Oregon, and consisting of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 as shown by the annexed plat of said Addition, found, in consideration of the benefits that may hereafter accrue, do hereby dedicate to Public Use, the Streets and Alleys shown by said plat. That the Lots and Blocks are of the dimensions shown on said plat, and the Streets and Alleys are of the width designated by said plat.
