Description of corner evidence found:
A slab from the pine bearing tree was found with he "BT" scribe visible.
No other poitive evidence was found at the corner. Evidence of the old fences were found that are now almost completely rotted away.

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 30° galvanized pipe with a bronze cap on top and an eight inch plate welded to the bottoms. The pipe was set to a depth of approx. 20° and back filled with atone and tamped earth.
