Due to a severe lack of original corners, especially to the South and East, I do not feel that a proportion would be in the best interest of the properties in this Section. Although I have found no direct connection to Arthur Curtis' survey of 1902, I feel the fences and blaze lines are, at least in part, based on his survey.

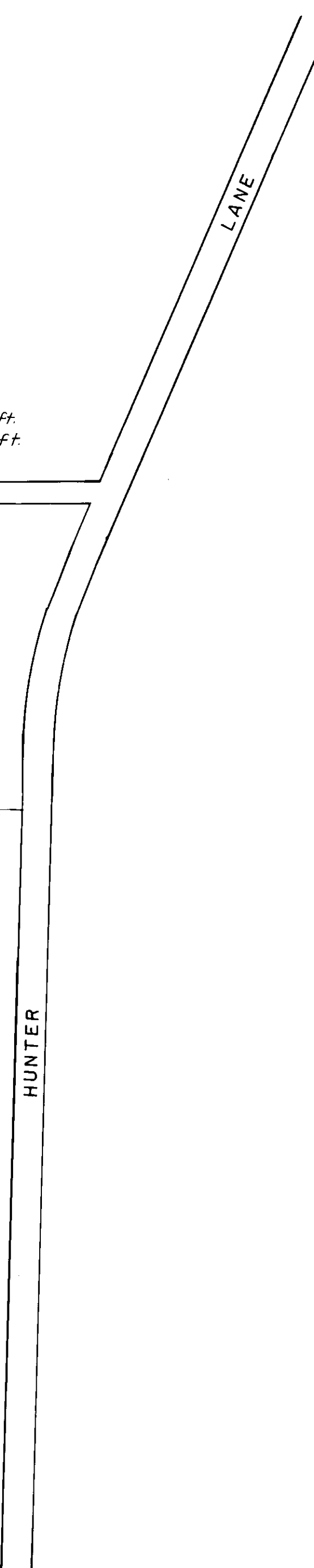
