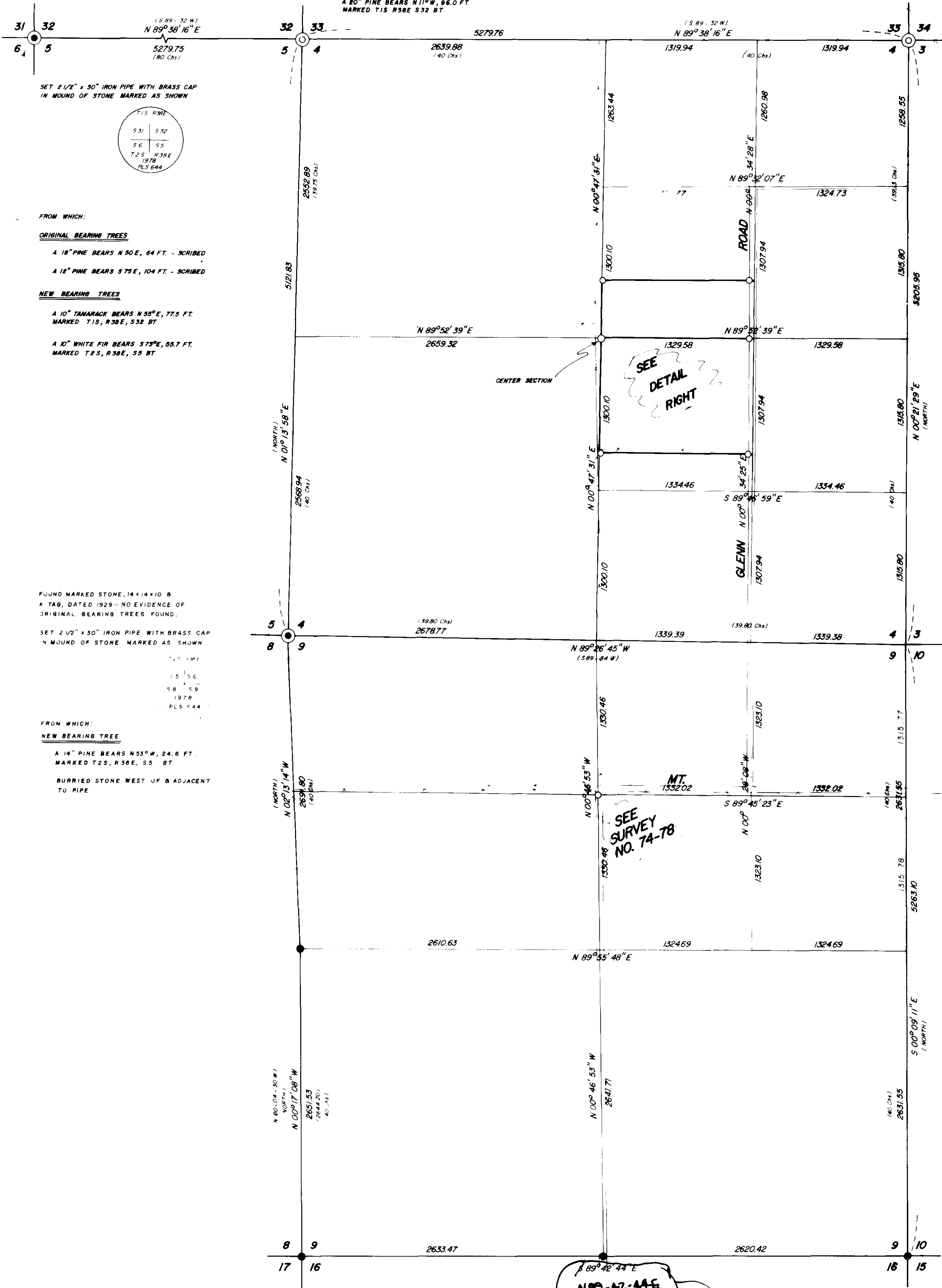


AT PROPORTIONATE DISTANCE,

ON THE EAST END FROM WHICH:

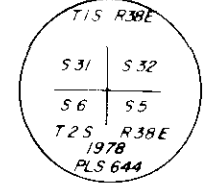

SURVEYOR'S STATEMENT

I FOUND THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 5, AS SHOWN, FROM THERE EAST I FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF ORIGINAL G.L.O. CORNERS, I THEREFORE ACCEPT THE FENCE CORNER AT THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 4, FROM WHICH THE ROADS AND LINES OF OCCUPANCY FIT HARMONIOUSLY FOR 2 MILES EAST. I THEN PROPORTIONED THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 4 AS SHOWN. I FOUND THE MARKED STONE AS SHOWN AT THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 4, I DID NOT FIND ANY OF THE ORIGINAL BEARING TREES. I FOUND A 5/8" PIN AT THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9 - THIS IS AN EXISTING FENCE CORNER, AND I FIND NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER. I LOCATED THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 4 AT THE PROPORTIONATE POSITION NORTH AND SOUTH FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 4 TO THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 9. THE EAST AND WEST POSITION IS BASED ON THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 9 TO THE ROADS AND LINES OF OCCUPANCY TO THE EAST 3 MILES

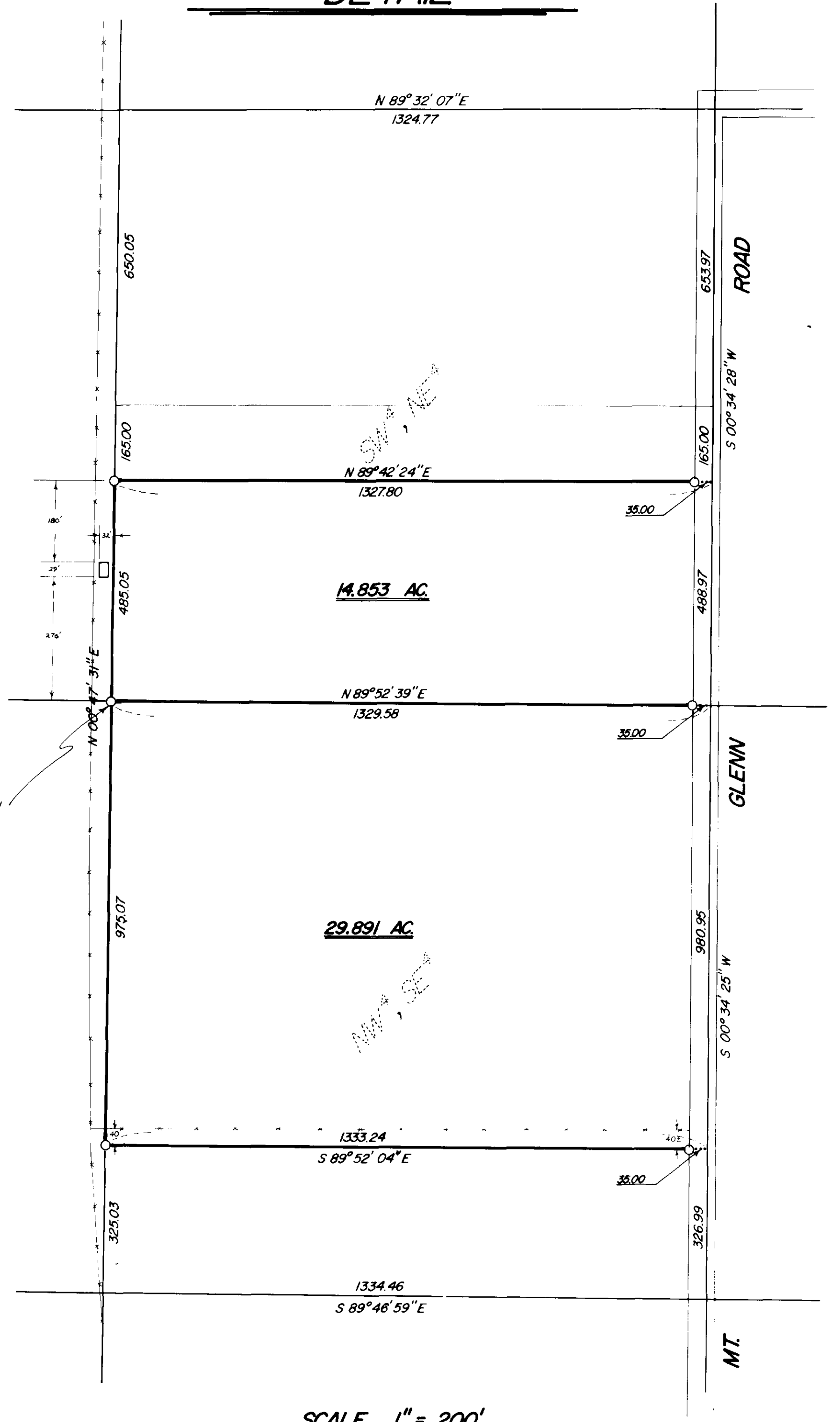
