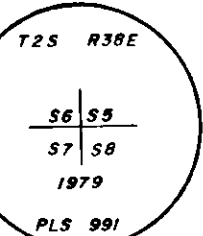

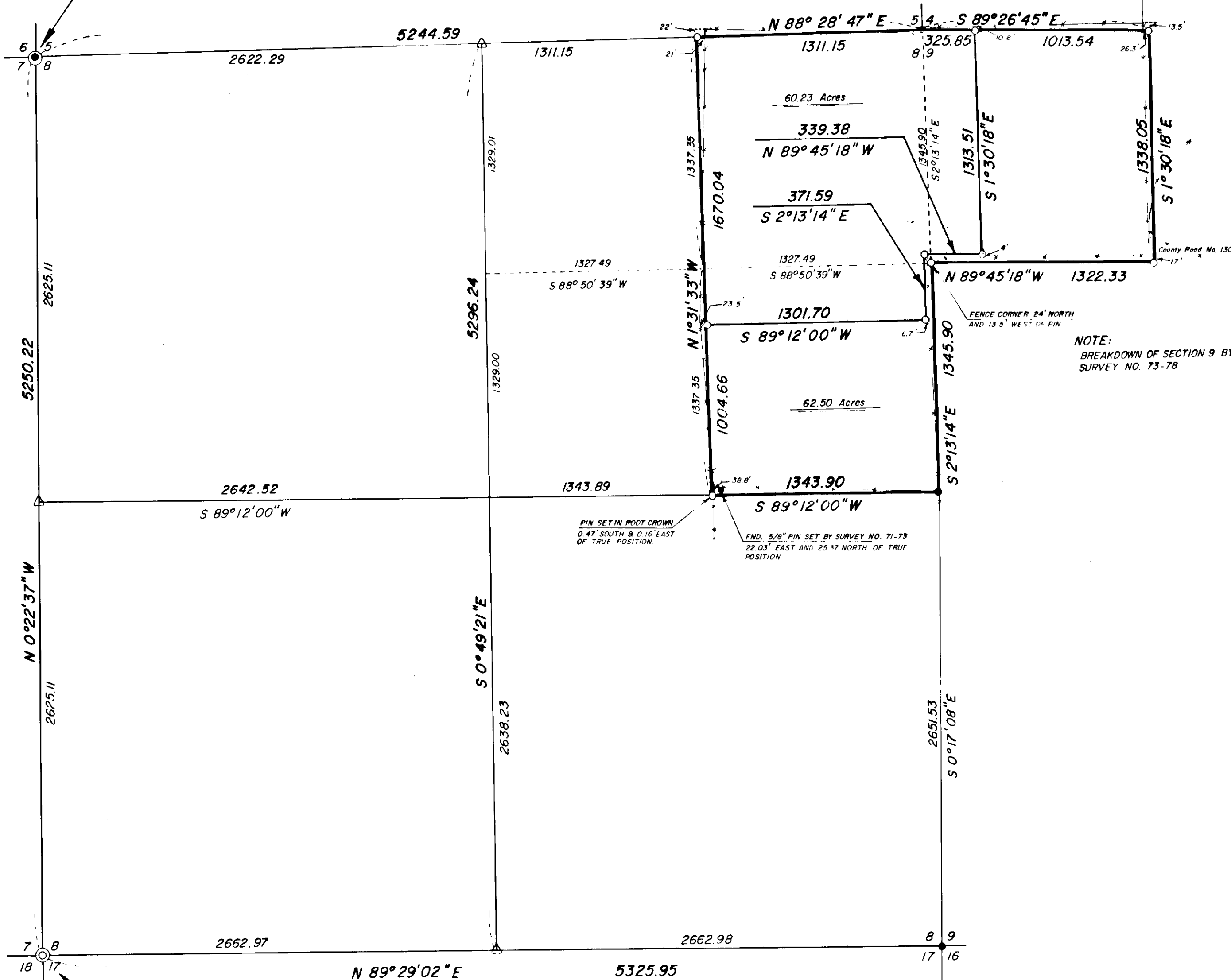

Map of Survey

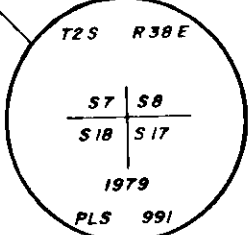
