NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

The monuments found at the intersections of W. Ave. and N. Depot St., V. Ave. and N. Depot St., and V. Ave. and N. Birch St. were accepted and used as shown on this survey map and the various reference surveys.

Direct measurement between the monument at the intersection of V. Ave. and N. Birch St. and the "Steel Nail" at the intersection of W. Ave. and N. Birch St. shows the actual distance to be 0.46 feet shorter than record.

This fact coupled with the vague history of the steel nail forces us to question its location and, therefore, we set a new intersection point on line and midway between the found monuments at the intersections of V. and X. Avenues with N. Birch St.

The dimensions of the parcel surveyed were determined by proportionate measurement after deducting the record distances allowed for the various streets and avenues.

All field work was carefully performed using Theodolite, electronic distance measuring device and steel tape.
