## **NARRATIVE**

This survey was done at the request of Darell Calhoun. Alder Street has been recently vacated and he wanted to pin his share of the vacated Street. There is some doubt as to who has rights to the vacated Street. The original plat of Grandy's Second Addition indicates no platting of Alder Street. The Supplemental Plat of Grandy's Second Addition shows Alder Street as being 60 feet wide on the drawing and the legal description calls only 40 feet. The concerned parties were expecting to acquire to the centerline, therefore all parties involved are in the process of a boundary agreement on the centerline of vacated Alder Street, as established in Survey Numbers 10-71 and 109-77. I set my pins on this basis, I found no unusual conditions on this survey.
