

This survey was performed to correct Union County Record Surveys 23-76 and 29-77. These prior surveys incorrectly placed the centerline intersection of Penn Street and Washington Avenue at the monumented centerline intersection of Washington Avenue and Greenwood Street. A careful review of the field notes and plat of McLain's 1922 survey shows the centerline intersection of Penn Street to be SE of the Greenwood Street intersection along the centerline of Washington Avenue as shown on this map.

All monuments set in Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 100 by Surveys 23-76 and 29-77 were removed. New monumentation was established as shown on this revised survey map. The East line of the West 55.50 feet of Lot 3 was not reestablished per the request of our client who is the owner of all of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 100. If established, this line would fall on the West edge of the sidewalk as shown. No encroachments were found, except as
