NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by Lavel Pfel to locate the property as shown. I based my survey on McLain's 1922 remonumentation of La Grande. I found all intersection monuments as shown and established the lots by standard proportionate method.

I ran a closed loop traverse on this survey and differed substantially in bearing from the three surveys listed in the reference material. These surveys are all based on survey number 85-72, which appears to have an error in bearing. Since all intersection monuments were found, this will not affect the position of the pins, it will be a difference in basis of bearing only. I did not locate the pins set by survey number 35-77 as all intersection monuments were found.

I find a slight encroachment of an out building near the Northeast corner as shown.

I find no other problems with this survey.
