NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by George Royes Jr. just for the purpose of remonumenting the corners shown. These corners were reset in 1889 by County Survey No. 93 in the old book of surveys on page 200, and by Imbler Orchard Tract. I located the West 1/4 corner of section 17, which was a well marked stone, which was called in the original plat of Imbler Orchard Tracts. The center of section, in my opinion was set by the survey on page 200 of the old book, however no record of a monument was recorded. Imbler Orchard Tracts indicated that the center of section was a stone. I therefore show the center of section as being set on Imbler Orchard Tracts. I found a stone 14"x9"x9" at the record distance on the true center of section line, at the

Northeast corner of Imbler Orchard Tracts. This stone has no record, however I am certian it marks the corner as the soil in the area is of loam and is free of stones to a depth of 3 to 4 feet. I also find fence posts set in concrete, within a foot or two of all the new monuments, which George Royes Jr., indicates his grandfather set to protect the corners. Mr. Royes' grandfather was P.E. Wade, and was one of the individuals that the aforementioned survey number 93 was performed for. This survey is not to locate property lines, it is only a pictorial record for the future to preserve the monuments.
