

The forward bearing as published by the U.S.C. and G.S. from \triangle College to \triangle Valley



NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by John Howton. Mr. Howton's description is a metes and bounds description and is junior to the property immediately to the West. The North line of the Howton property is the center of section line, which was located by tying the East 1/4 corner and the center 1/4 corner of section 7. The West line of Howton was established by coming call distance along the center of section line to the Northeast corner of the property conveyed by deed located in book 141 page 143. The Howton West line calls by deed "South 120 feet" and the South line calls at right angles to the West line to a point that bears S 5°W of the point of beginning. The East line of Howton is described as being a line S 5°W of the point of beginning, however this same line was monumented by H.L. Melton on August 17, 1947 (survey number 19-75). I find his monuments at the center of section line and to the South 899.67 feet. I accept this line as the intended line of conveyance. The Northeast corner of Howton, set by Melton is 1.50 feet too far West on the ground, when compared to deed call, therefore Howton's North line is short by 1.50 feet. The North line is a more or less call and as stated above is treated as a remnant. I find no other problems with this survey.
