NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey is to field locate the boundaries of property acquired by the Island City Area Sanitation District for Sewage Pump Station No. 4.

Review of the Deed Records (MF 90738 and 101489) indicates that this property is to be located adjoining the West right-of-way line of McAlistar Lane, and perpendicular to it, with the SE corner of the property located 580.00 feet North of the South boundary of Section 3, T.3S., R38E.

Road and deed records establishing McAlistar Lane appear to be non-existent, affording no information about the location and width of the roadway. It appears that this road has been established through the long-time use of the public and should be considered as a public usage road, located as it exists on the ground. Deeds No. 90738 and 101489 indicate that the West right-of-way line is 35 feet West of and parallel to the N-S centerline of Section 3. I can find no basis for this right-of-way width or alignment in the Union County survey and deed records or in field conditions in this area.

Oregon State Highway Dept. drawing 7B-7-1 (1951) shows a surveyed centerline for McAlistar Lane, apparently based on the average location of the existing improvements along the roadway. Union County Survey No. 56-71 has established a relationship for the 0.S.H.D. centerline survey to existing survey monuments in the area. We feel that OSHD drawing 7B-7-1 and Survey 56-71 have established a reasonable location for the centerline of McAlistar Lane as it exists on the ground. We have utilized this centerline as shown on this drawing.

In lieu of documentation specifying a right-of-way width for McAlistar Lane, we have used the existing fences as the best evidence of the accepted right-of-way lines for this specific survey. The right-of-way as determined by the fences is 60 feet and is generally centered on the surveyed centerline in this area.
