#### NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by Jack Bond to set the property corners of the parcel shown. I base my survey on survey number 86-78, which located Block D of Coggan's Second Addition. Survey number 86-78 was a survey to amend survey number 58-78, and some minor changes were not made. This is the reason for the discrepancy (2 or 3 hundredths) in distances of the East-West lines. Survey Number 86-78 placed all of the excess in Block D to the South. As shown by the dashed line on the above map, this excess ranges from 8.42 feet to 9.16 feet. Mr. Bond has recently acquired additional property from the adjacent owner to the South. This was needed to keep Mr. Bond's house from encroaching onto the property to the South. Mr. Bond acquired the North 13 feet of the adjacent property. The description of this transaction is somewhat nebulous. I contacted Mr. Bond, and in our conversation, he clarified the intent as to the additional property acquired. This survey represents the intent of the transaction. I find no other problems on this survey.
