

NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by Bill Anhorn of the Oregon State Highway Department. I base my survey on survey number 25-84. I find that the unrecorded survey by the Oregon State Highway Department was done incorrectly in that the surveyor did not break the section. The legal description of the State property is dependent on the location of the Southeast corner of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 4. The description further describes the Highway Department East line as being the East line of the West half of the East half of Section 4. I located the controlling corners and find a conflict on the West line between the Oregon State Highway and Robert D. Goss. Goss and the Highway Department decided to agree on a common line. My instructions

were to use the existing fence (running N 31°08'31"W) and intersect the South line of Highway 82, and extend S31°O8'31"E to a point 4.82 feet East of the fence going Southerly (SO°21'43"E) and run 4.82 feet East and parallel to that fence, South to the intersection of the South line of Goss (deed microfilm no. 47596). I would then run Westerly along the Goss line to the Oregon State Highway Department title line. I have prepared legal descriptions for the exchange of deeds, and I have prepared a corrective description for the Highway Department for their parcel. I find that all of the descriptions adjoining the State property to the West and South are dependent on the Highway Department description and therefore extend to its boundaries as placed. show the title lines of the access to Holmes Road. The existing gravel road occupies the Southern portion as shown.
