Narrative

I made this survey at the request of Keith Chandler. I proceeded by first locating the sectional breakdown corners as described. By using both single and double proportioning methods to breakdown the section further to meet the deed description requirements. In the deed I find that the road is written as an easement. Upon proportioning the breakdown of section 33 I find the 5/8" rebar set at the EV4 and the center of section 33 (set by C.S. 56-73) to be out of their true position as shown. Because the S I/4 was removed during ditch construction which came after C.S. 56-73, I used that survey to determine its original position. With the exterior boundaries of the section determined, further sectional breakdown was done as described above and shown to the right. These procedures completed this survey-
