


BASIS OF BEARING

NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by Vern Pridgen. The Pridgen description is a metes and bounds description beginning at the center of Section 3. The center 1/4 corner has never properly been set, nor has the section been broken. All of the descriptions along McAllister Lane have been written from a point called the center of Section 3. I established this point on the center of section line by locating the Southeast corner of survey number 39-69 and extending Easterly along the bearing shown, to the North-South centerline of Section 3, then Southerly along the center of section line 788.05 feet. From this center of section, I extend Northerly along the center of section line call distance to the point of beginning of the Pridgen tract. I established the North and South lines of the Pridgen tract by turning the interior angle from the record bearing of the North-South centerline of Section 3. I established the West line of the Pridgen tract by using the interior angle (established by deed) and applying it to my South line bearing. Mr. Pridgen's description reads to the North-South centerline of Section 3. I set reference pins on the West right of way line of McAllister Lane as shown. I established the West right of way line by extending the East line of survey number 58-76 South as shown. Mr. Pridgen intends to establish a joint ownership on the existing house. I establish the division line by tying in all of the corners of the house, and splitting it in half. The angle point of the division line was established at the edge of the existing asphalt. Mr. Pridgen then pointed out the direction of the line extending West to the intersection of his West line. I find no other problems with this survey
