NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by W. Lee Jeffers to locate the South line of Lot 15, May Park Addition. This line is also the Northerly right of way line of the Union Pacific Railroad. I establish this line by coming 60 feet Southerly and parallel to the South line of survey no. 64-74. This is also 160 feet Northerly and parallel to the North line of survey no. 87-72. I established the Southeast corner of Lot 15 by intersecting the North line of the railroad right of way and the Southerly projection of the East line of survey no. 64-74. I establish the Southwest corner of Lot 15 by intersecting the North line of the railroad right of way and the 1/16 line as established by survey no. 25-84, which provided the breakdown of Section 4. I find the plat of May Park conflicts with the dedication of the plat. The dedication calls for subdividing all land in the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 4 and that portion of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 lying North of the railroad right of way. The plat extends South of the Center-West 1/16 corner some 60.53 feet. I accept the plat as going South to the railroad right of way on the basis of intent, as McWhirter owned this additional property also, and has never transferred any deeds conflicting with this assumption. Mr. Jeffers also wanted to show the location of a wooden barricade built near the Southeast corner as shown. Mr. Jeffers has obtained a lease from Union Pacific Railroad for ingress and egress over a triangular piece of ground South of the Southeast corner as shown. This document is not recorded in the Union County Clerk's office, but is filed in the Union Pacific Railroad records as lease number 105969 and was provided to me by Carey and Joseph, attorneys at law. I also find a sign encroaching onto Union Pacific Railroad right of way 7 feet as shown. I find no other problems with this survey.
