NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by George Butler. I establish the South line of this property by retracement of survey number 104-72 which established the South line of the Butler property. I establish the North line by tying the O.S.H.D. monuments at E.B. station 125+00 (P.O.T.) and E.B. station 132+25.72 (P.S.). I then intersect the South line of the O.S.H.D. right of way and the projected West line of survey number 104-72. The East line was done in the same manner. I find no other problems with this survey.
