I, Duane I. Griffith, Registered Land Surveyor in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that this plat and the notes hereon, or attached, are a true and correct representation of the survey I made in April, 1986, at the request of the USDA, Forest Service, in accordance with the statutes of the State of Oregon, and with the articles of my contract.

This survey was accomplished by a closed traverse. The entire area has been extensively logged, which has destroyed several G.L.O. corners. The topo call in the G.L.O. notes, to Meadow Cr. on the west line of section 23 is too rough to be used for the location of the NW corner of section 23. I found no unusual conditions in this survey.
