NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by Don Mooney. The intersection of Adams and Cedar was established by survey number 47-79. Survey numbers 89-72 and 47-79 both found the 3/4" pipe at Cedar and Jefferson. This monument has since been destroyed by street construction. I established this position by coordinate from survey number 47-79. The intersection of Adams and Alder was established by coordinate on survey number 109-77. Survey number 109-77 also established the intersection of Jefferson and Walnut. I establish the intersection of Oak and Adams by intersecting a straight line between the found monuments at Oak and Main and at Oak and Palmer, and a line between the established intersection of Cedar and Adams and Alder and Adams. Oak and Jefferson was established by a straight line intersect between the monuments at Oak and Main to Oak and Palmer, and the established intersection of Cedar and Jefferson and Walnut and Jefferson. I then establish the block corners, and proportion the lot corners into position. I find no problems with this survey.
