

NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by Bob Osterman of Peoples Savings and Loan. The legal description of this parcel is intended to be a four acre tract lying North of the North right of way line of Booth Lane and the East line was described as the East line of the Northwest quarter of Section 26. This parcel was once a part of the Gettle property, where Paul Gettle deeded his sons this four acres. It is my professional opinion that they measured from the existing fence on the East, 417.5 feet to the West to obtain the West line, and measured down this East fenceline from the North line of the County Road 417.5 feet.

Due to lack of monumentation in this area, we have not located the East line of the Northwest quarter of Section 26. We intend to establish the West and North lines, as well as the East line by boundary agreement. I established the center of Booth Lane by starting at the West quarter corner of Section 26 and splitting the traveled way to the East of this parcel approximately 1000 feet down the road. I used the existing fenceline along the East line of this parcel as the boundary agreement line.
