SURVEY NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED DURING AUGUST-NOVEMBER, 1992 FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVISING THE LOCATION OF MONUMENTATION ESTABLISHED DURING THE PERFORMANCE OF UNION COUNTY SURVEY NO. 104-78. SURVEY NO. 104-78 WAS PERFORMED UNDER A CONTRACT WITH THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST DURING 1978 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING PORTIONS OF THE BOUNDARY OF FOREST AND PRIVATE LANDS IN SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 40 EAST. DURING THE COURSE OF THIS SURVEY, SEVERAL ORIGINAL SURVEY CORNERS WERE DECLARED LOST AFTER AN UNSUCCESSFUL SEARCH FOR EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY. GIVEN THAT CERTAIN SURVEY CORNERS WERE LOST, THE LOCATIONS OF THE CORNERS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE SURVEY WERE DETERMINED BY PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT PROCEDURES, THE MONUMENTS WERE ESTABLISHED, AND THE SURVEY WAS DOCUMENTED AND RECORDED WITH UNION COUNTY, AND ACCEPTED BY THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST.

IN 1987, THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST CONTRACTED WITH WILLIAM P. WELLS, OREGON LAND SURVEYOR NO. 1106, TO POST THE NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY IN SECTION 16. IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THIS SURVEY, MR. WELLS RECOVERED EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL GENERAL LAND OFFICE (GLO) SURVEY AT THE LOCATION OF THE 1/4 CORNER OF SECTIONS 16 AND 17. THE RECOVERY OF THIS EVIDENCE INVALIDATES THE 1978 LOCATIONS OF THE WEST AND NORTH 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 16 AND THE NORTHWEST AND NORTHEAST CORNERS OF SECTION 16, AND PROVIDES THE REASON
