

## NARRATIVE:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO LOCATE AND MONUMENT THE SOUTHWESTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT LINE OF FOREST SYSTEM ROAD NUMBER 63, THROUGH LOT 4 OF SECTION 1.

## HISTORY.

1884, FRANK W. CAMPBELL, U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR, SUBDIVIDED THE TOWNSHIP UNDER CONTRACT NO. 498.

1968, THE U.S. FOREST SERVICE AQUIRED THE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR ROAD 63 (ROAD N451) BY CONDEMNATION ACTION UNDER AN ORDER OF POSSESSION DATED JUNE 10, 1968 (EXHIBIT B, DECLARATION OF TAKING NO. 68-321).

1980, DUANE I. GRIFFITH, REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR NO. 644, SURVEYED THE LINE BETWEEN SECTIONS 1 AND 2 FOR BOISE CASCADE CORP. (UNION COUNTY SURVEY MAP NO. 4-81).

## PROCEDURES:

THE SURVEY WAS PERFORMED USING A TOPCON GTS-4 TOTAL STATION. A TRIMBLE 4000 GPS RECEIVER SYSTEM, WHICH WAS OPERATED BY A CONTRACTOR TO THE FOREST SERVICE, WAS USED TO DETERMINE THE POSITION OF JARBOE GPS.


THE TWO REFERENCED DOCUMENTS HAVE ONLY THE CORNER OF SECTIONS 2 AND 3, T. 3 N., R. 39 E., & SECTIONS 34 AND 35, T. 4 N., R. 39 E., IN COMMON. ORIGIN OF BEARING ON THE 1968 EASEMENT SURVEY (EXHIBIT B) IS MAGNETIC COMPASS. THE EASEMENT SURVEY BEARING WAS ROTATED 41 MINUTES LEFT SO THE COMPUTED ROAD CENTERLINE AND GRIFFITH'S 1980 SURVEY ARE ON THE SAME BEARING BASE.

FIELD BOOK 1 IS ON FILE AT THE SUPERVISOR'S OFFICE OF THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST AT PENDLETON, OREGON.
