REFERENCE MATERIAL

Union County survey 8-84

Plat of Highway Acres Subdivision

This survey was ordered by Michael Kozak who owns Lots 15, 16, 17, and 18 except for the East 188 feet of Lot 16 of Highway Acres Subdivision. Mr. Kozak requested that the North lines of Lots 16 and 17 be monumented. Including those points on the North line where it intersects the lines monumented by survey 8-84.

I base the location of Lots 16 and 17 on survey 8-84. As discussed in the Narrative of survey 8-84 Highway Acres was platted Southerly onto property owned by others. This results in Lots 16 and 17 being approximately 20 feet short of the record width.
