

NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Stan Wilde, representing Boise Cascade Corporation. The purpose of this survey is to monument the corners of and mark the property lines along the East and West lines of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 24 and the East half of the Northwest quarter of Section 25, Township 3 South, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian. I used the existing monumentation as shown for the placement of the lines needed. The only confrolling corners not previously monumented were the North and South quarter corners of Section 24. Survey number 16-73 calls finding a mound of stone and a pine stump with a possible blaze at the North quarter corner of Section 24. No monument was set in 1973. I could find no evidence of the mound, or the stump, as there has been significant logging in the area. I place the corner at proportionate position. The South quarter corner of Section 24 has never been monumented since the original corner was set. Again, there has been significant logging and disruption in the area and no evidence of the original corner monument, or it's accessory could be found. This corner was also placed at proportionate position. The West lines of these sections were located and monumented by survey numbers 30-86 and 33-88, which were on a different basis of bearing than the 1979 survey. This is the reason for the approximate 2 minute rotation of the bearing along the range line. Having located the controlling corners as described, I then subdivided the sections in accordance with the BLM Manual of Surveying Instructions (1973). I find the existing blaze lines along the posted portion of this survey to be very harmonious with the true posted line. I did find a fence along the Northerly portion of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 24 to be East of the frue line by approximately 60 to 80 feet as shown. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.
